The air packs/SCBAs which have exceeded their expected useful life will be replaced with new air packs/SCBAs that can be updated or repaired per current NFPA standards.

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The fire department will serve the citizens of Sanford by providing fire and emergency medical services in response to 911 calls for assistance.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The fire department would be wearing the air packs/SCBAs while responding to fire or fire alarm calls, and emergency medical calls performing life and property saving services for the City of Sanford's citizens, workforce, and visitors.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire fire department will be wearing the new air packs/SCBAs while responding to fire or fire alarm calls and emergency medical services to all citizens, workforce and visitors of the City of Sanford. The fire department, as a whole, responds to over ten thousand 911 calls each year with the total number of calls increasing each year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The fire department will have the equipment to respond to fires and medical emergencies in the City of Sanford which directly protects the general public from harm. Dispatched call reports are generated per fire station, departments, and units reflecting the types of services/protection provided within the City of Sanford.
