14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this project is to establish a state of the art conference center space for organizations and individuals to host various types of events and gatherings. The center will serve to unite the community by bringing people together to work on wider community projects, encourage creativity and culture, share valuable community information, and offer educational activities. Additionally, because of the historic nature of the building, this project is seen as a way to preserve the past while at the same time enhancing the local economy and the county's tourist development attractions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Jackson County is currently underway with the designs for this project and intends to be complete by the spring of 2023. Upon completion of the design, the county will then facilitate the improvements to the building by conducting the formal procurement process for capital improvement projects (advertise for sealed bids for construction). Following the advertisement, physical construction on the project will begin until completion. Upon completion, the county will market this facility for its intended purpose as a conference and event center.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The conference center will be provided to the public as a safe space to gather or meet to hold various types of events including conferences, weddings, speaking engagements, concerts, job fairs, entertainment, etc.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will primarily serve the citizens of Jackson County (est. population 48,000). Additionally, with the improvements the center will be able to host larger events potentially attracting clients and visitors from several hundred miles in either direction of the county. The facility is located in close proximity to the interstate between several large communities such as Tallahassee, Panama City, Pensacola, and Dothan, AL.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased revenue from increased event space capacity (metric: funds generated). Enriching the cultural experience of the citizens by providing a safe indoor recreational space for individuals and organizations to host events (metric: number of events, happiness surveys). Increase in tourism because of the meeting hall capacity (metric: number of tourists).

De-obligation of funding, failure to request additional funds in the future.
