Raise the four lift stations out of flood areas to prevent sanitary sewer overflows.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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Improve quality of life by reducing sanitary sewer overflows, keeping waters free from raw sewage spills and provide cleaner water to sustain the local shellfish and wildlife environment. Ensure regulatory compliance and support the head works expansion.  
 Keep beaches clean and promote tourism.  
 Energy savings by reducing amount of storm water to be pumped and treated.

All of the 21,000 Lynn Haven residents plus other citizens that come to our city to enjoy water recreation activities.

 A reduction in sanitary overflows that can be tracked by today's numbers versus what it will be once this project is completed.
