a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the project is to provide flood relief and improved water quality to our clients, staff, and vehicles. This project will remove flood waters from the lot in this heavily traveled area. It will provide critical drainage capacity for storm-water runoff, thereby reducing lot flooding (both volume and duration), and the frequency of property damage and personal injury.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The project includes but is not limited to the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, equipment, machinery, expertise, services, and all else necessary for proper construction and completion of the project consisting of excavation, installation of storm drain piping, clearing and grubbing, constructing concrete catch basins and inlets with grates, headwalls, grading, back-filling and street (lot) repair and repaving, installation of erosion control measures, and installation of swales and grass sodding.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will remove flood waters from our ADT loading/unloading lot. It will provide critical drainage capacity for storm-water runoff, thereby reducing lot flooding and the frequency of property damage and personal injury to clients, staff, and vehicles.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project is all the clients, staff, and vehicles that drive, walk, and unload/load in our lot. It is a highly traveled and used lot.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The purpose of this project is multi-faceted, with one objective set to reduce storm water staging in the basin and the other to significantly increase water quality. The outcomes will be measured through water quality testing and basin capacity reports.
