**4. Project/Program Description**

SW 34 Terrace is a low-lying road within the western limits of Dania Beach, consisting primarily of single-family homes and commercial structures adjacent to a state highway. Since there is limited stormwater infrastructure the area floods and the roadway becomes impassable, particularly at the neighborhood's only entrance. The 100% designed and permitted project includes the installation of new catch basins inlets, drainage piping, regraded swales, and a pipe network of 15-inch and 18-inch RCP pipes will be installed along SW 34th Ter. Also, two existing outfalls will connect discharge into the Dania Canal. SW 34th Ter. will be raised. Overall, the project will alleviate flooding on SW 34th Ter. and provide additional water quality treatment and storage prior to discharging into the Dania Cut-Off Canal. The cost estimate for this project is \$1,000,000. Therefore, the City requests \$500,000 in funding and will provide a \$500,000 match for the project.

The City received approximately \$449k in CARES Act funds from Broward County which was used for the Covid-19 response, including: PP&E, Covid-19 tests, communications efforts, facility sanitization, acrylic barriers/shields, indoor air purifiers, signage, and other critical items. Additionally, the City received an allocation of \$16.2 million through SLFRF, and expended \$10 million in revenue replacement funds toward public safety payroll expenditures, and the remainder is being programmed.

The project will move stormwater from SW 34 Terrace to an adjacent canal, through adjacent swales and improvement of stormwater infrastructure. The other purpose is to make the neighborhood more resilient to flooding and sea-level rise.

Construction activities by a third-party contractor.

Flooding relief by decreasing the duration of flood waters that block access to emergency response to residents. Decrease the likelihood of damage to homes and commercial property by flood water.

The target population of this project is the residents of SW 34 Terrace, located in Broward County Census Tract 804.05, Block Group 1. This area is made up of 53.38% Low and Moderate Income persons.

The expected outcome is less flooding and decreased duration of flooding. Visual inspection of the street after rain events.
