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The installation of new drainage pipe and the reshaping and reconfiguration of the existing pond.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The pond and drainage improvements will improve the quality of the water that flows downstream to the Yellow River. This will increase the water quality for wildlife and humans. There will be fewer of the existing homes in flood prone areas. The homeowners within and downstream of the drainage basin will have a significant reduction in the chance of flooding. This should decrease their insurance costs and improve their financial security and overall wellbeing.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There are 28 homes within the typical flood area of this pond.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit will be to reduce the number of road closures during subsequent major storm events. Also, to reduce the turbidity of the water entering Red Wash Branch. These can both be measured after any subsequent major storm event.
