c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The residents of the City of Hialeah benefit from having their own police department to respond to emergencies throughout the City. The Mobile Command Center will augment the Police Department's response to large scale emergencies in the City such as natural disasters, mass casualty incidents, hostage situations, and other situations requiring multi-jurisdictional response.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will target no particular group, and will serve the general population of the City of Hialeah by augmenting the Police Department's ability to protect and serve the residents of the City. The population of the City of Hialeah is roughly 220,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The addition of a Mobile Command Vehicle to the City of Hialeah's Police Department will improve communications between Police Command Staff and officers responding to a mass casualty incident, natural disaster, or other situation requiring mass response coordination within the Department as well as with other pertinent agencies. The improved communication with other departments responding to a particular scenario will be one measure of improvement in the City's Police services. Furthermore, these benefits will also be measured by improved officer safety while they are in the line of duty or engaging a perilous real world scenario.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The City of Hialeah is willing to be bound by the standard penalties for breach of contract in the State of Florida. Furthermore, the City is willing to contemplate additional penalties the Agency may propose.
