a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Decrease unnecessary use of Emergency Rooms in the Panhandle. Give Florida residents in the Six Counties (Bay, Walton, Holmes, Jackson, Calhoun, and Gulf) covered in this pilot the option to see a telehealth provider immediately.

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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Guardian Angel 360 will provide a free download of state-of-the-art technology to offer patients the opportunity to connect immediately with a leading telehealth provider in the State of Florida who can determine the type of care needed. This could be anywhere, including their home. The telehealth medical professional will either address the patient's need or direct the patient to the most appropriate care provider.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

When a patient is headed towards or sitting in an Emergency Room, Guardian Angel 360 technology will offer teh patients the opportunity to connect immediately with a telehealth provider who can determine the type of care needed for the patient. The patient could also opt in from their home to utilize the service. The telehealth medical professional will either address the need or direct the patient to the most appropriate care provider.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is inclusive of ALL residents in the following Counties: Bay, Gulf, Calhoun, Jackson, Washington, and Walton.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Decrease total number of patients waiting to see a physician in an ER for non-emergent care. Decrease over-use and crowding of ER and subsequent exposure to infectious diseases in ER's. Decrease costs of care to patients, self-insured employers, hospitals, physicians' groups, and payers. Avg Costs of ER visit \$3,200 vs telehealth at \$80 (savings of \$3,120 per patient that did not go to an ER for non-emergent care. Nationally, Florida ranks #1 in ER costs per visit. Our methodology will be measured through our app and AHCA's HIE data management system. We will count the number of patients who use telehealth through GA360 and thus avoided a non-emergent ER visit. We will compare the amount of time a patient waited with GA360 to be triaged by a medical professional vs ER wait times.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

This is a pilot program to see if the State of Florida can be successful at improving human life by improving access to appropriate care. As a pilot, we cannot know the extent of its success until it is complete. We will work diligently with AHCA and the State of Florida to provide improved access to care in these rural counties while reducing non-emergent ER visits. Failure to meet deliverables would result in the penalty of concluding the pilot.
