The requested funding will expand the Water Treatment Plant capacity to the permitted and designed buildout. The increasing and exponential need for additional housing requires the city to respond with adequate and sustainable utilities to support the additional demand. Expansion will allow the water treatment plant to produce 12 million gallons per day of finished, treated, potable water for Fort Myers residents and allows for increased resiliency and modernization of an essential city facility.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds? The City will have the ability to treat and service an additional 3 million gallons per day of water, allowing an increase in distrributed utilities to the citizens of Fort Myers. It will also mitgate potential loss of resources in the event of disaster, by increasing the availability of resources. The expansion will add and promote resiliency within the city.
