14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Water quality improvements to the Choctawhatchee Bay and watershed are expected through the requested funds. By reducing nutrient pollution entering Cinco Bayou, a tributary of Choctawhatchee Bay and the Gulf of Mexico, the project supported by the requested funds will align with regional initiatives to reduce pollutants entering surface waters and a reduction in the likelihood of harmful algal blooms.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The construction project includes hydraulic restoration of an eroded stream channel and adjacent vegetated floodplain within the Town of Cinco Bayou's Glenwood Park. An existing stormwater outfall pipe which discharges into the stream will be retrofit through addition of a baffle box and other best practices, in a treatment train approach to improve the quality of the stormwater runoff prior to outfall into the stream and Cinco Bayou, which is a tributary of the Choctawhatchee Bay.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Choctawhatchee Bay Estuary Program will develop and implement creative programs and projects that engage and educate partners and the public in improving the environmental quality of the Choctawhatchee Bay estuary. The project will be used as a demonstration project to increase environmental awareness through environmental education.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Resolutions supporting the Choctawhatchee Bay Estuary Program have been signed by local governments. The Okaloosa, Walton, Holmes, and Washington County Commissions have entered into an interlocal agreement supporting initiatives of the Estuary Program, such as the described project, to address protection and restoration of water quality in the Choctawhatchee Bay and its tributaries. Residents and visitors to the region surrounding Choctawhatchee Bay will benefit from water quality improvements which may be expected from the project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Water quality improvements to Cinco Bayou, the Choctawhatchee Bay, and watershed are expected. The Choctawhatchee Bay Estuary Program is proposing to maintain and expand the existing water quality program. The data and analysis obtained for this project will be utilized to assess the health and management of the Choctawhatchee Bay, Choctawhatchee River, and watershed.
