Program runs both day and night classes at capacity and jobs in this field are in high demand in our area. Graduates will benefit from being trained with current equipment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Bring essential equipment for the auto collision vocational certificate program up to accreditation standards so that students graduate with experience in the most current technology.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Students interested in attaining a NATEF-certified vocational certificate in auto collision repair and refinishing, leading to jobs that are in high demand in our area. Day and night classes serve over 20 students in each cohort (40 total) and students may enroll in fall, spring or summer terms.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Updated laboratory equipment will lead to improved certification rates and better job prospects for enrolled students. Both of these outcomes can be measured.
