CS/HB 6515 — Relief/Estate of Herminio Padilla, Jr./the City of West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, the City of Lake Worth, the City of Riviera Beach, and the Town of Palm Beach

by Civil Justice Subcommittee and Representative Fernandez-Barquin (CS/sCS/SB 200 by Committees on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Judiciary and Senator Cruz)

The bill provides \$100,000 for the relief of the estate of Herminio Padilla, Jr. As he was walking on a catwalk above a sewage basin, the grate on which Mr. Padilla, Jr., was walking fell out of the catwalk causing him to fall into the basin and drown.

If approved by the Governor, or allowed to become law without the Governor's signature, these provisions take effect upon becoming law.
