




"AEROSPACE" DEFINED IN FLORIDA STATUTE

"Aerospace" means the technology and industry related to the design, manufacture, maintenance, repair, and operation of aircraft or any other device intended to be used or designed for flight or reentry, including rockets, missiles, spacecraft, satellites, space vehicles, space stations, space and aircraft facilities or components thereof, and related equipment, systems, facilities, simulators, programs, and activities, including, but not limited to, the application of aerospace and aviation technologies in airbased, land-based, space-based, and sea-based platforms for commercial, civil, and defense purposes.





CONDUIT DEBT OBLIGATION

Conduit financing is a means for private companies, nonprofit organizations, and public entities to raise capital via municipal bonds to fund large-scale projects that typically benefit the public.



Attributes

- Construction or acquisition of the capital asset is financed with the proceeds from the Conduit Debt Obligation.
- Issuer retains title to capital assets from arrangement beginning.
- Third-party obligor lease payments to cover the debt service payments.
- Payment schedule coincides with debt service schedule.






