What are Problem-Solving Courts?



- ❖ Problem-solving courts (PSC) address the root causes of justice involvement through specialized dockets, multi-disciplinary teams, and a non-adversarial approach
- ❖ Offering evidence-based treatment, judicial supervision, and accountability, PSC provide individualized interventions for participants

Types of Problem-Solving Courts



❖ **Drug Courts** (s. 397.334, F.S.) – 85

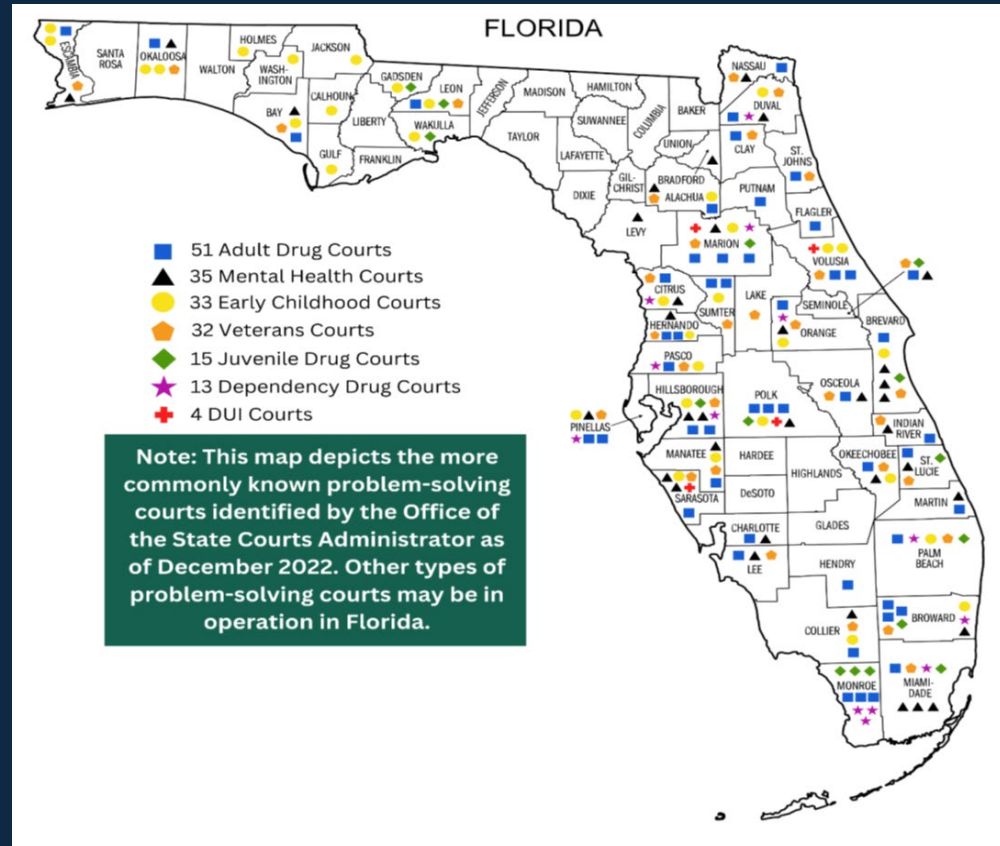
- *Adult Drug Courts* – 51
- *Juvenile Drug Courts* – 15
- *Dependency Drug Courts* – 13
- *DUI Courts* – 4
- *Other (Marchman Act & Domestic Violence)* – 2

❖ **Mental Health Courts** (s. 394.47892, F.S.) – 35

❖ **Veterans Courts** (s. 394.47891, F.S.) – 32

❖ **Early Childhood Courts** (s. 39.01304, F.S.) – 33

Problem-Solving Courts Statewide



Best Practice Standards



- ❖ Research-based practices proven to be effective
- ❖ National standards established for adult drug courts and dependency drug courts (family treatment courts)
- ❖ State standards established for adult drug courts and early childhood courts

Legislative Oversight



Section 43.51, F.S., requires an annual report on:

- Number of participants in each PSC for each fiscal year the PSC has been operating
- Types of services provided by the PSC
- Sources of PSC funding for each fiscal year
- Performance of each PSC based on outcome measures

Annual Legislative Appropriation



- ❖ Special category recurring appropriation in the General Appropriations Act
- ❖ \$11.4 million for FY 2022-23
- ❖ Portion of funds (\$9.5M) allocated by Trial Court Budget Commission (TCBC)
 - Allowable costs specified in proviso
 - Match required for certain problem-solving courts and counties

TCBC Allocation of Appropriation



- ❖ TCBC developed funding guidelines
- ❖ Currently 89 problem-solving courts receive funding

Other Funding Resources



- ❖ County and city government
- ❖ Local trust funds
- ❖ County ordinances/court fees and fines
- ❖ State agencies (e.g., DCF, DC, DJJ)
- ❖ Federal grants
- ❖ Participant fees

Performance Measurement



- ❖ Various ways of measuring performance at local level
- ❖ Critical performance indicators for drug courts at state and national level
 - Recidivism
 - Retention
 - Sobriety
 - Units of Service (for outpatient, inpatient, and ancillary services)
- ❖ Need to define critical performance indicators for other PSCs

Statewide Data Collection



- ❖ Florida Drug Court Case Management System (FDCCMS)
 - 108 problem-solving courts currently utilizing
 - 800+ system users

- ❖ Florida Dependency Court Information System (FDCIS)
 - 31 early childhood courts currently utilizing

Key Research Findings



- ❖ Reduced recidivism
- ❖ Higher rates of treatment completion
- ❖ Cost savings/cost avoidance
- ❖ Improved functioning for veterans
- ❖ Reduced out-of-home placement for children and increased family reunification

Leon County Adult Drug Court



- ❖ Program implemented in 1993
- ❖ 30 new admissions in calendar year 2021
- ❖ 96 participants served in FY 2021-22
- ❖ State funded
- ❖ Financial assistance provided for individuals with no income or health insurance

Leon County Adult Drug Court



- ❖ Program cost is less than incarceration
- ❖ Reductions in criminal behavior and drug abuse
- ❖ Frees up prison and county jail beds for the violent offenders and serious criminal cases
- ❖ Stops revolving door that police officers see in community involving individuals whose criminal conduct is due to an addiction issue

Leon County Adult Drug Court



Drug court team strives to be non-adversarial with emphasis on being supportive and more creative in developing personalized assessments and treatment plans, and providing care to participants.

Leon County Adult Drug Court



Drug court works! It is the court of second chances, giving participants an opportunity to start anew.

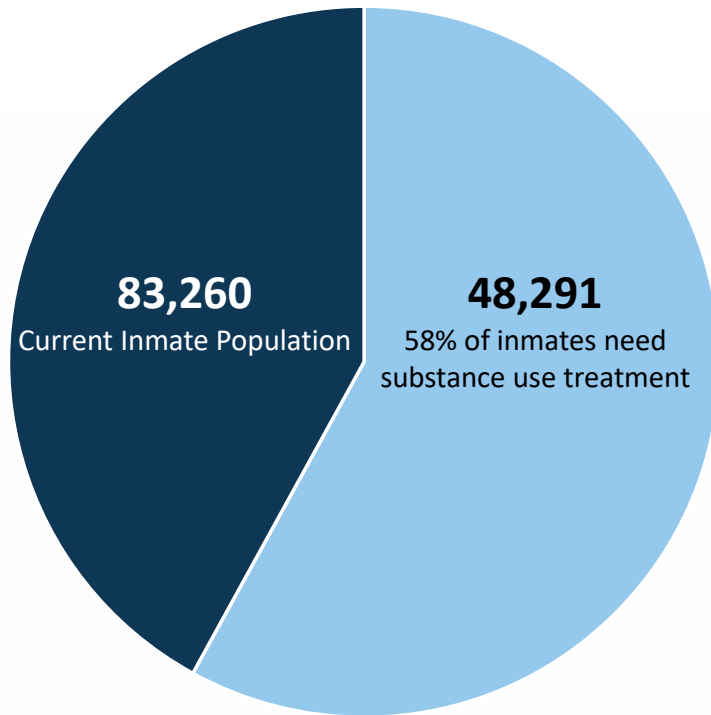
Inmate Telephone System

Global Tel*Link/ViaPath

- 5-year revenue generating contract (signed December 2020)
- Includes:
 - Inmate telephone system
 - Infrastructure
 - Equipment installation
 - Monitoring/security systems
 - Centralized database
 - Phone lab for criminal intelligence
 - Ongoing maintenance
 - Training materials
- Provides \$5 million annually to General Revenue



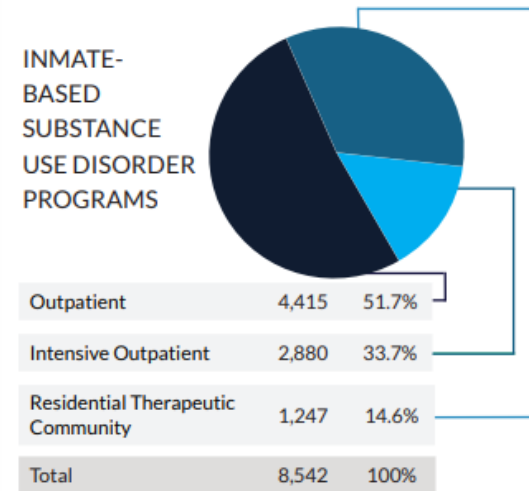
Substance Use Treatment Requirements



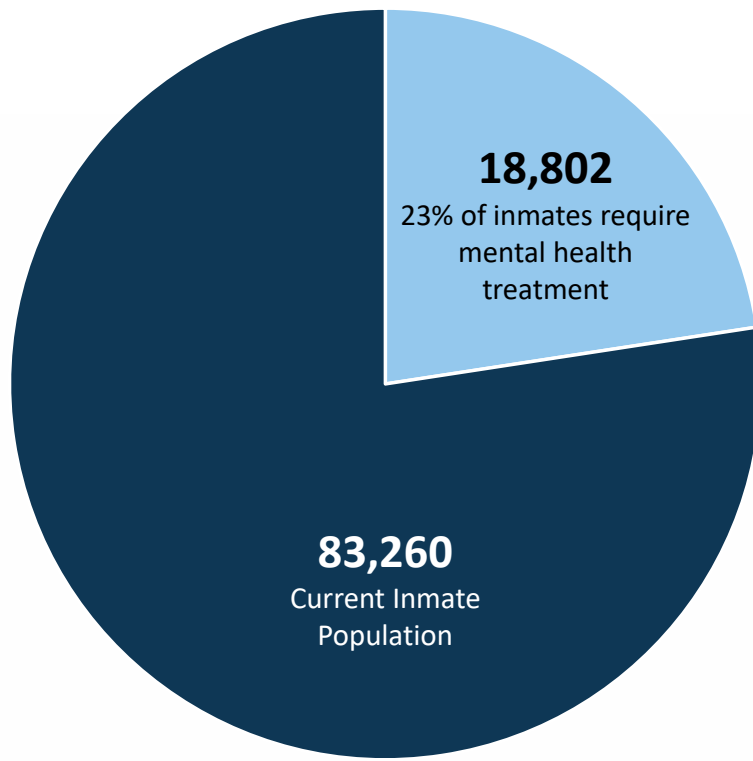
- Only 12% will receive treatment
- Most will only be placed in a program once they are within 60 months of release
- 40% will end their sentence still needing treatment

Substance Use Treatment Offerings

 - Outpatient
 - Intensive Outpatient
 - Modified Residential Therapeutic Community
- Substance Use Prevention
 - Cognitive-Behavioral Programming
 - Addiction Education
 - Parenting
 - Victim Impact
 - Anger Management
 - Domestic Violence



Mental Health Requirements



- 97% of inmates receiving mental health services are served on an outpatient basis
- Rate of persons with a diagnosed mental illness has steadily increased since Fiscal Year 2016-17
- Rates for self-injury and suicide have steadily increased since Fiscal Year 2010-11

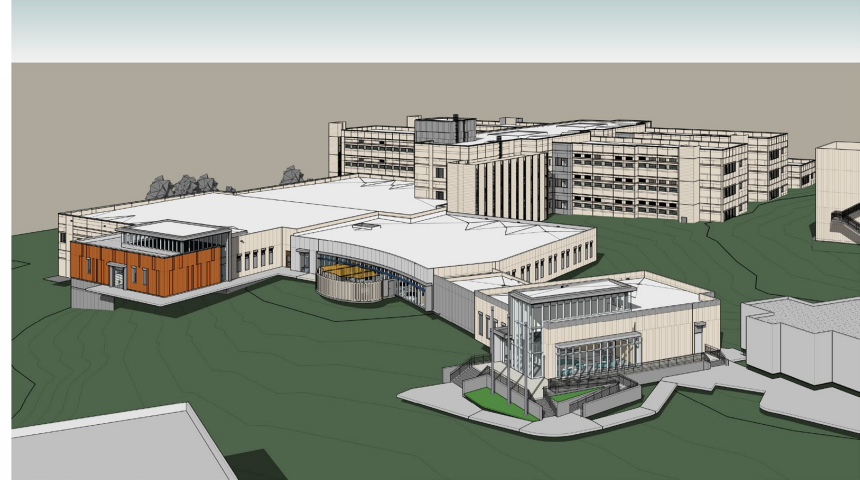

- Outpatient Services

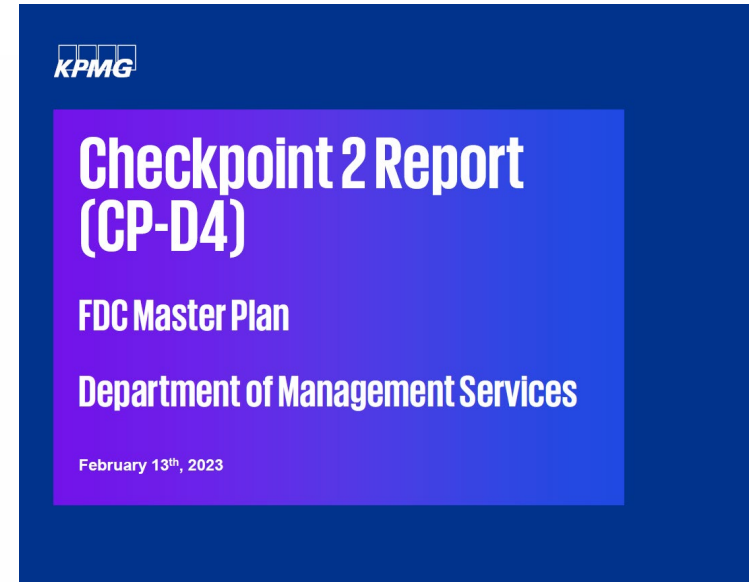
- Residential Mental Health Continuum of Care Units

Prison Modernization and Staffing Study

- Multi-Year Department of Corrections Master Plan
- Objectives:
 - Comprehensive forecast of Florida's corrections requirements to 20 years
 - Recommended courses of action for meeting those requirements
- DMS is lead agency, FDC in support
- Three tracks:
 - Facility assessment
 - Staffing and requirements
 - Forecasting
- On time – initial report delivered
- Final product due December 2023

July 2020 – June 2021

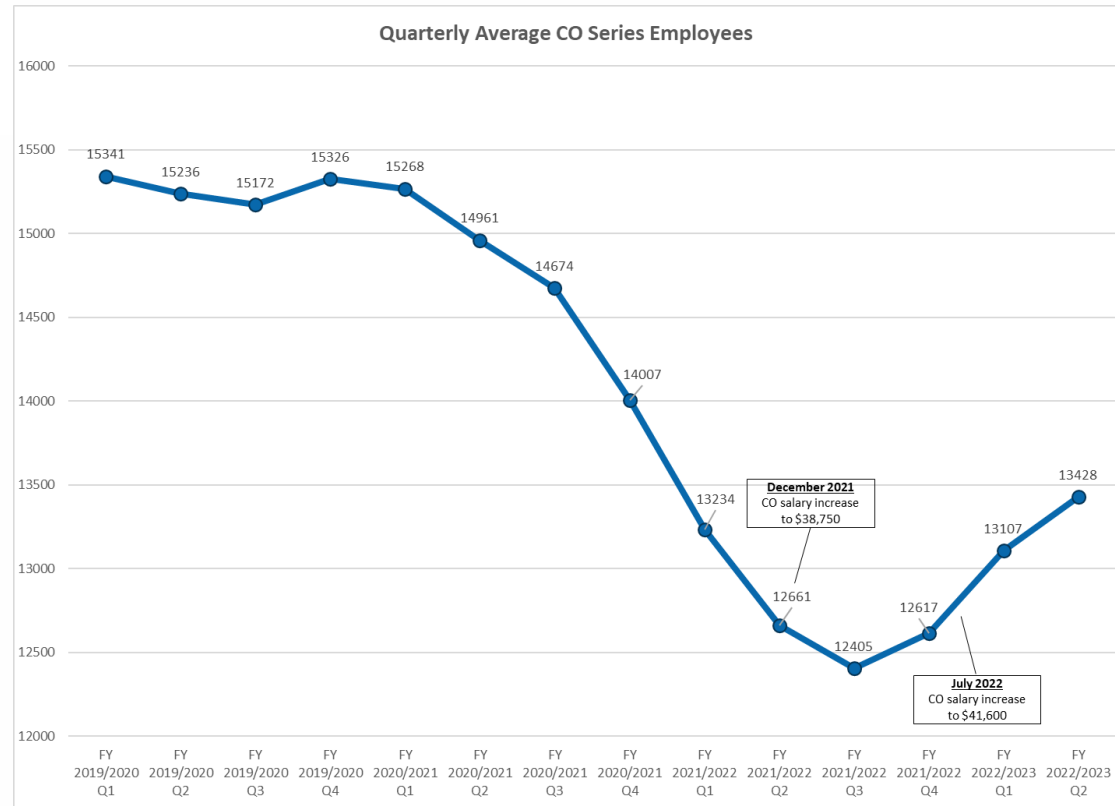
FDC had a **net loss** of 1,432 Correctional Officer (CO) Series employees

July 2021 – June 2022

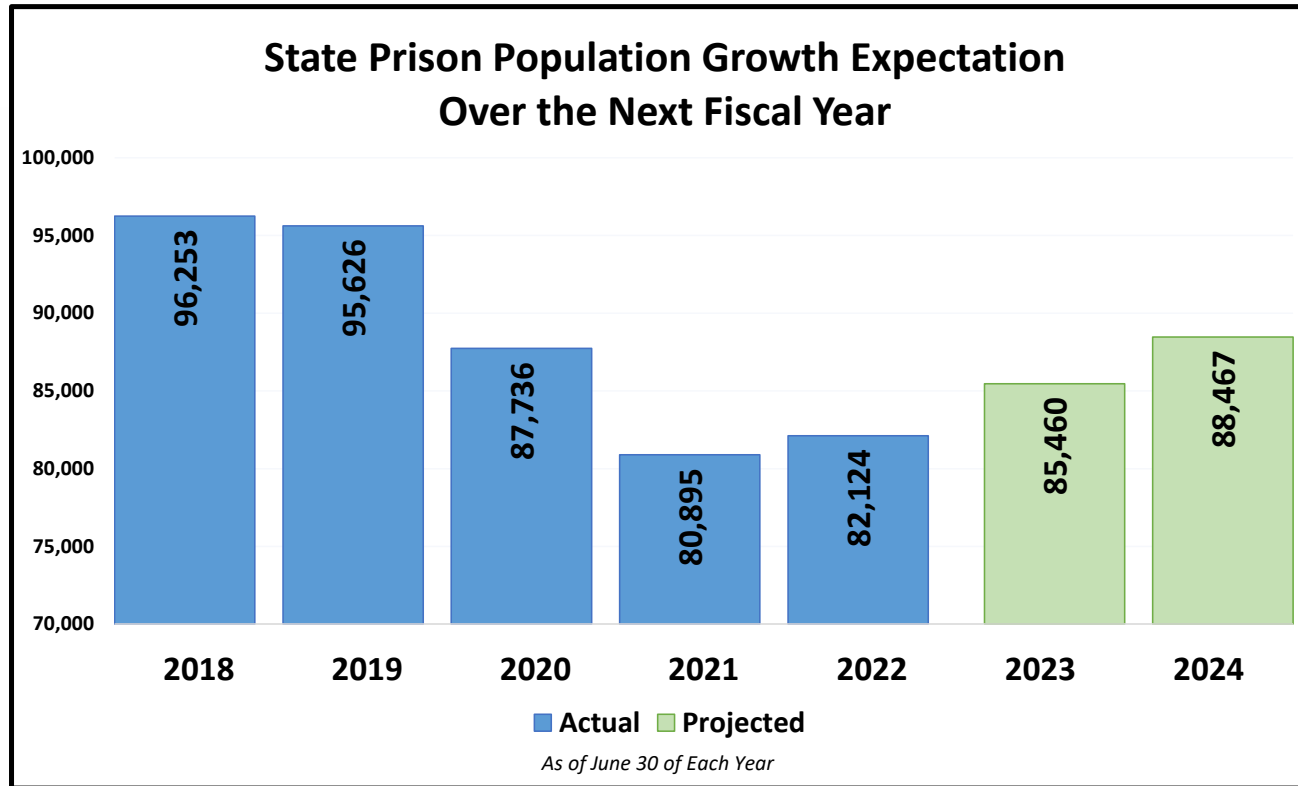
FDC had a **net loss** of 683 CO Series employees
