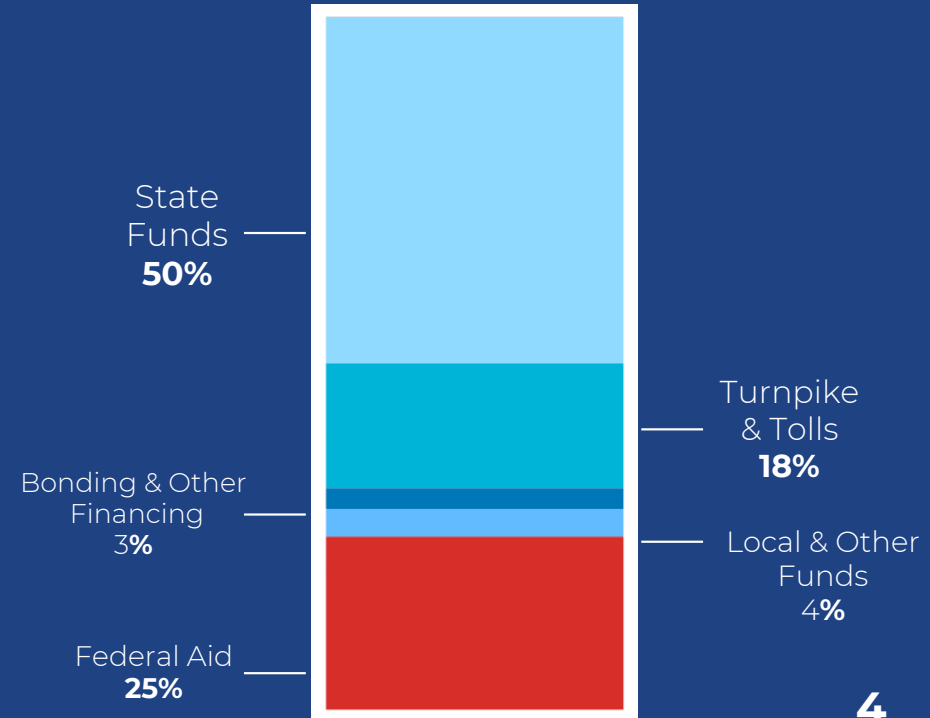

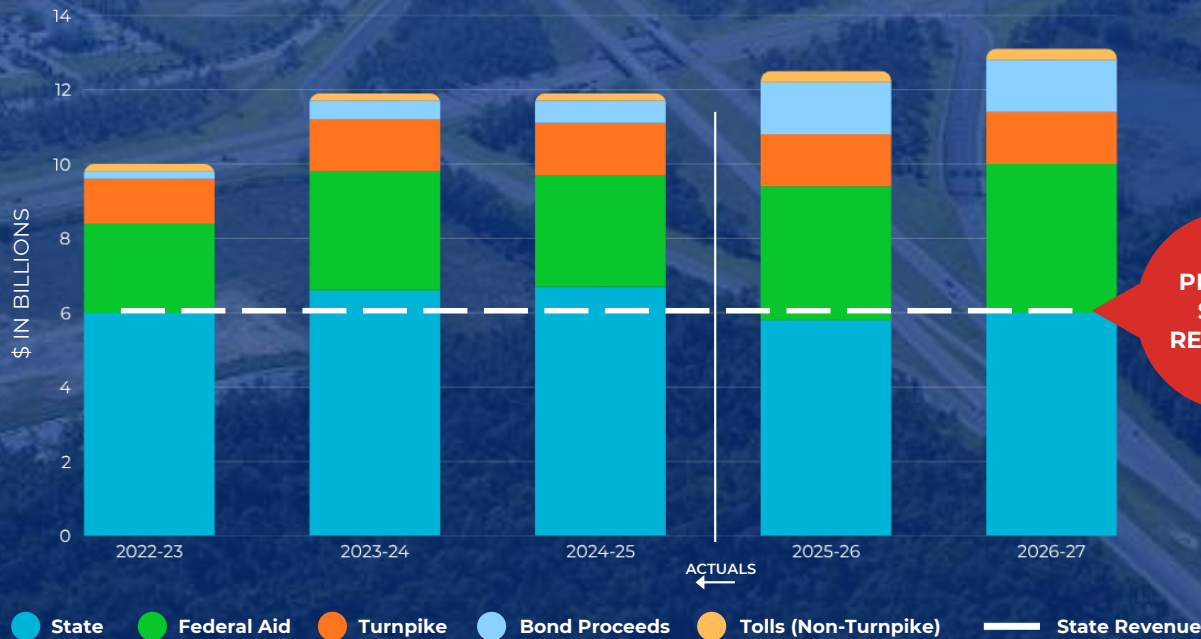

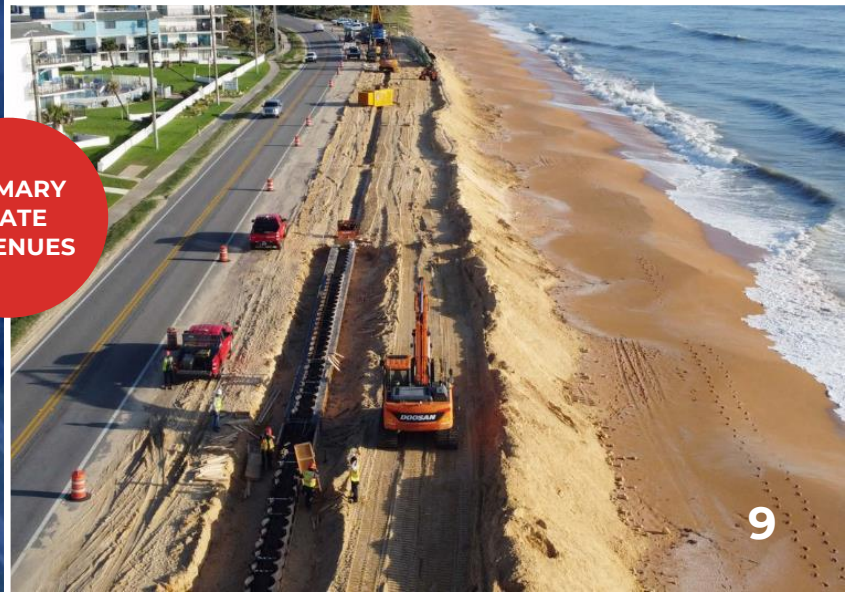

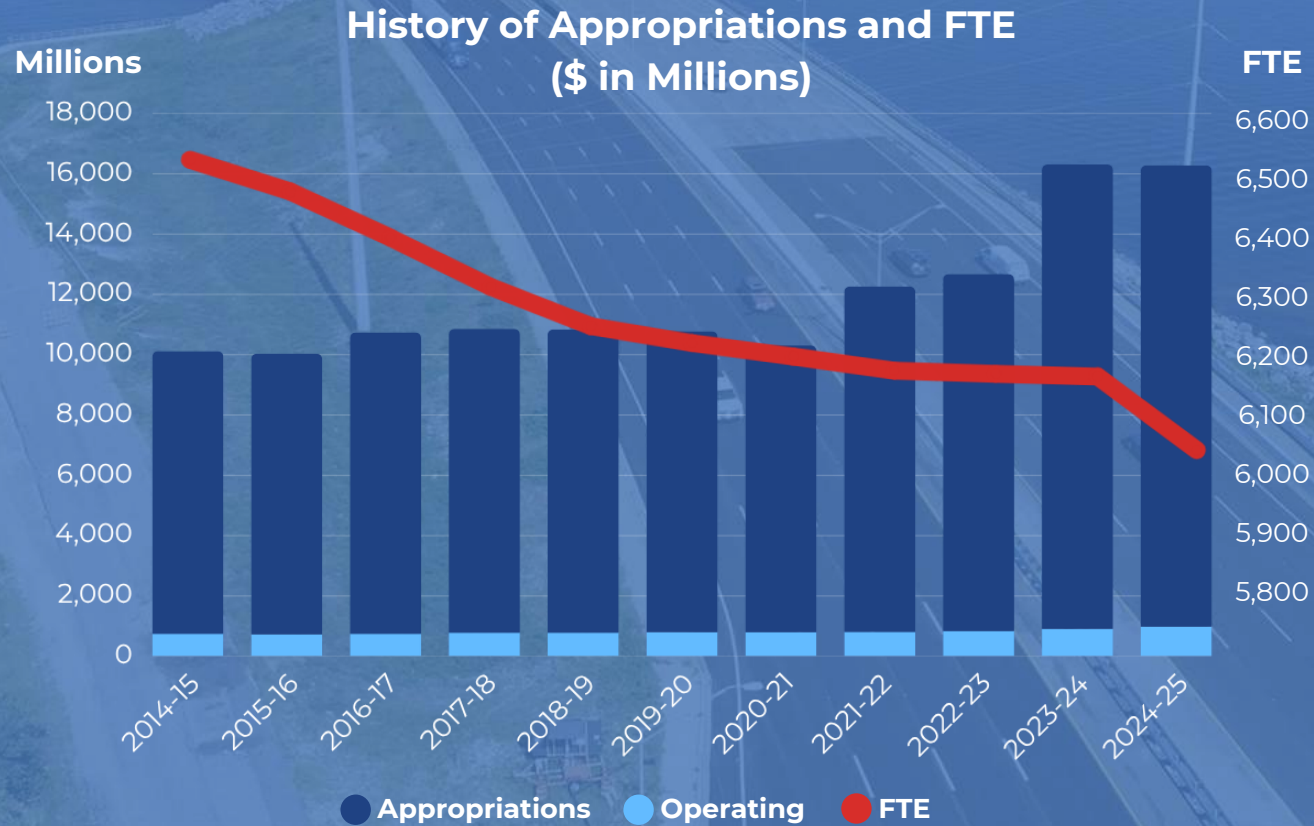

INVESTMENTS IN ACTION

Thanks to investments from Governor DeSantis and the Legislature, FDOT has replaced nearly **120 pieces** of heavy equipment since 2022!

The average age of FDOT's heavy equipment has been reduced from 17 years old to 14 years old due to these critical funds





REPLACEMENT OF ESSENTIAL FACILITIES

FDOT's facilities are essential to efficiently operate the state's transportation system & serve as vital emergency response hubs.

With critical funding fully secured, FDOT is now able to replace & modernize its nearly 90-year-old regional operations center in Chipley

Replacement of primary FDOT facilities in various parts of the state are essential due to frequent flooding & impacts to heavy equipment

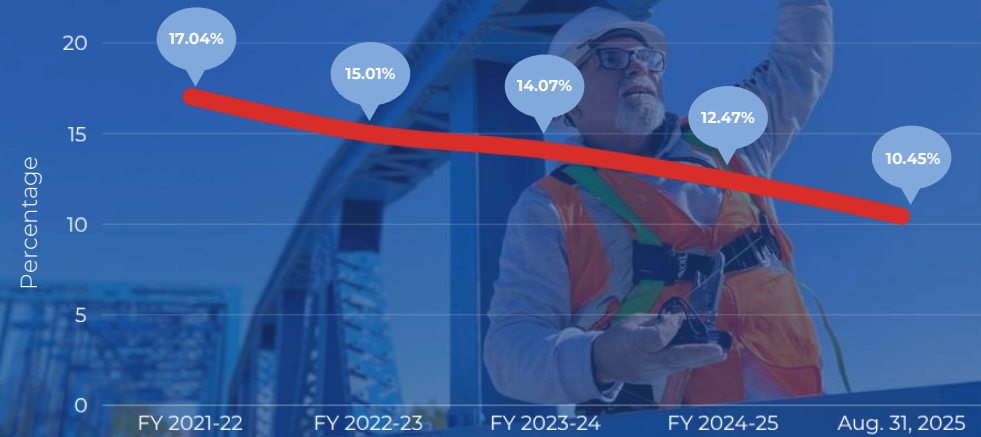

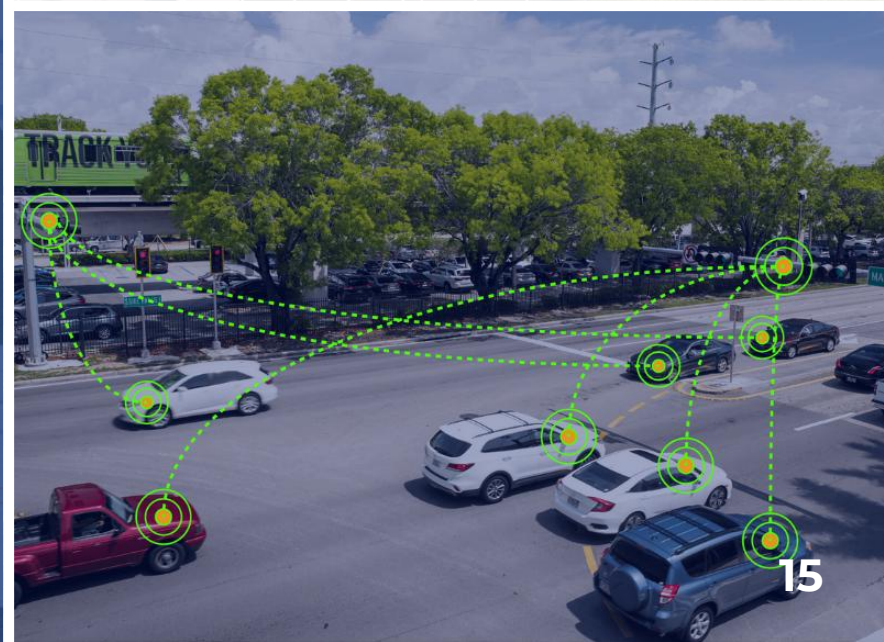
