Market-Based Parity Pay Adjustment for Recruitment and Retention of Direct Care Positions

Funding is needed to address recruitment and retention concerns associated with positions in the Juvenile Justice Detention Officer (JDO) I, JDO II, and JDO Supervisor classes and positions in the Juvenile Justice Probation Officer (JPO), Senior JPO, and JPO Supervisor classes.

Electronic Monitoring Technology Enhancement

Funding is needed to provide for the procurement of more technologically advanced electronic monitoring equipment to improve tracking and monitoring of youth in our communities.

Funding is needed to provide for a dedicated contracted staff member to assist with the migration, integration, and implementation of the new Florida Planning, Accounting, and Ledger Management (PALM) system.

Total Request = \$181,278 (GR)



Transition from an Electronic Medical Record to an Electronic Health Record

Funds 3.00 additional FTE positions and acquisition of necessary equipment to facilitate the transition from the DJJ's Electronic Medical Record (EMR) to the establishment of an Electronic Health Record (EHR) to ensure compliance with federal, state, and community standards of care.

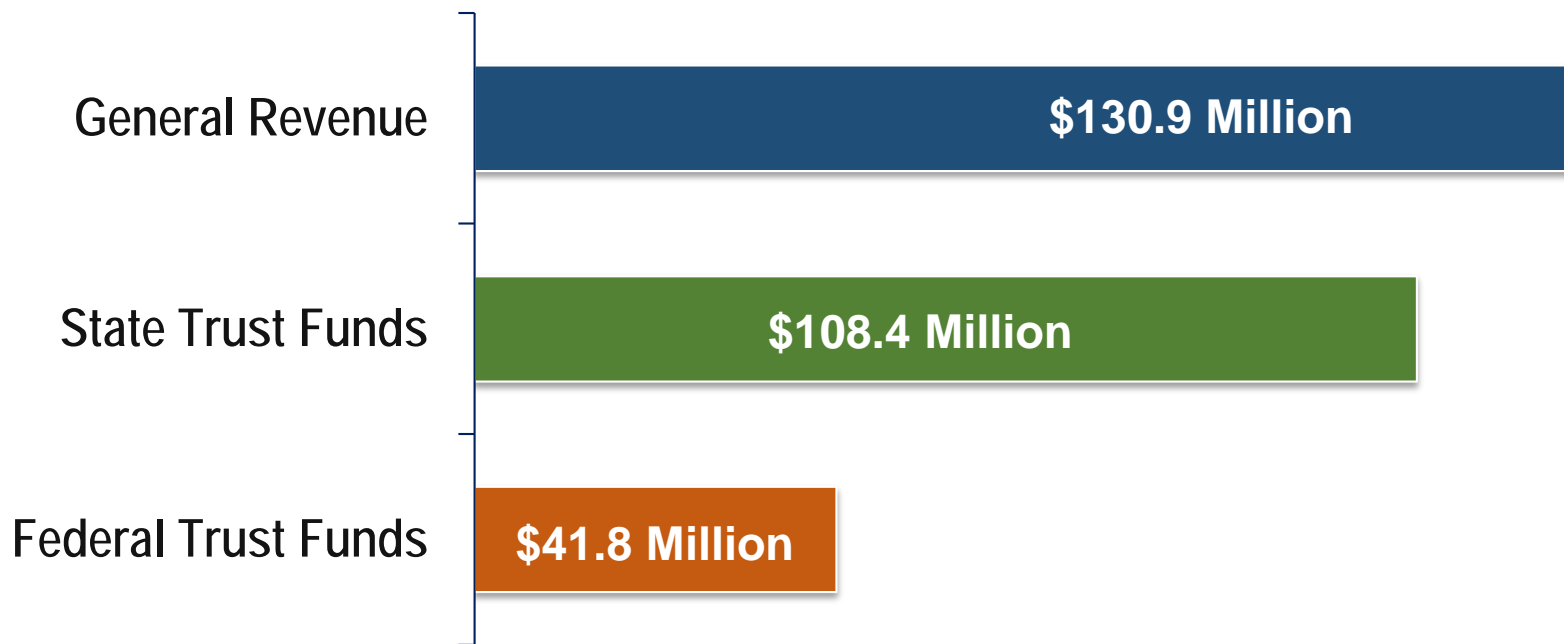

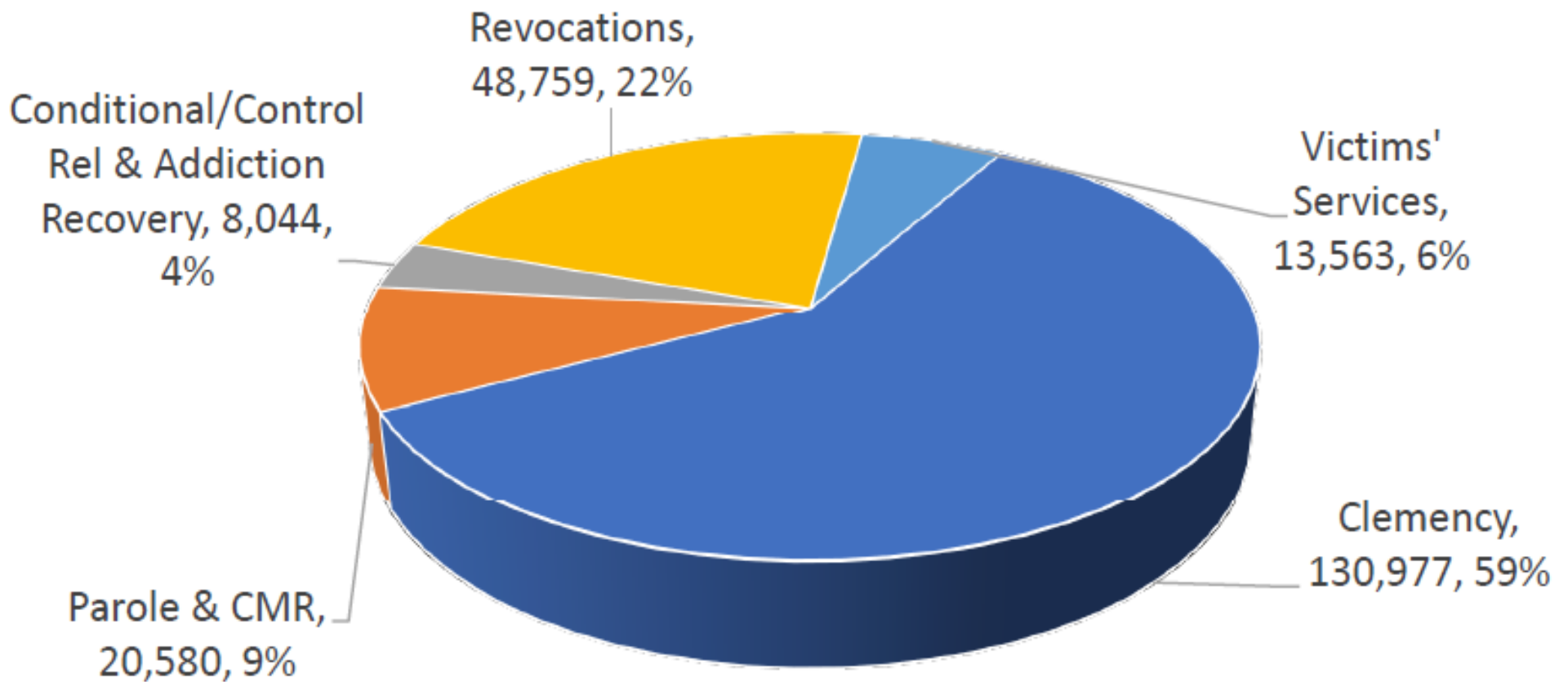

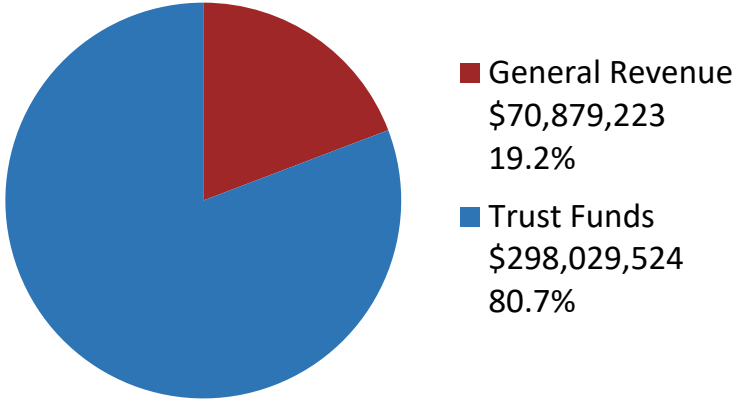
Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Legislative Budget Request

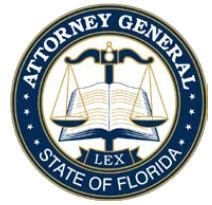

Office of the Attorney General 2021-22 Approved Budget



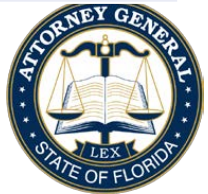
