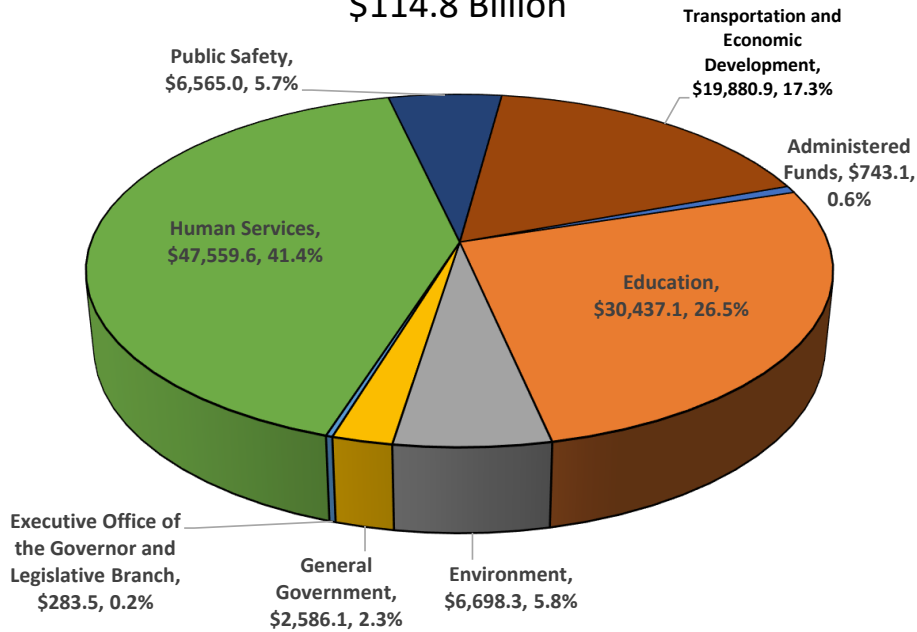

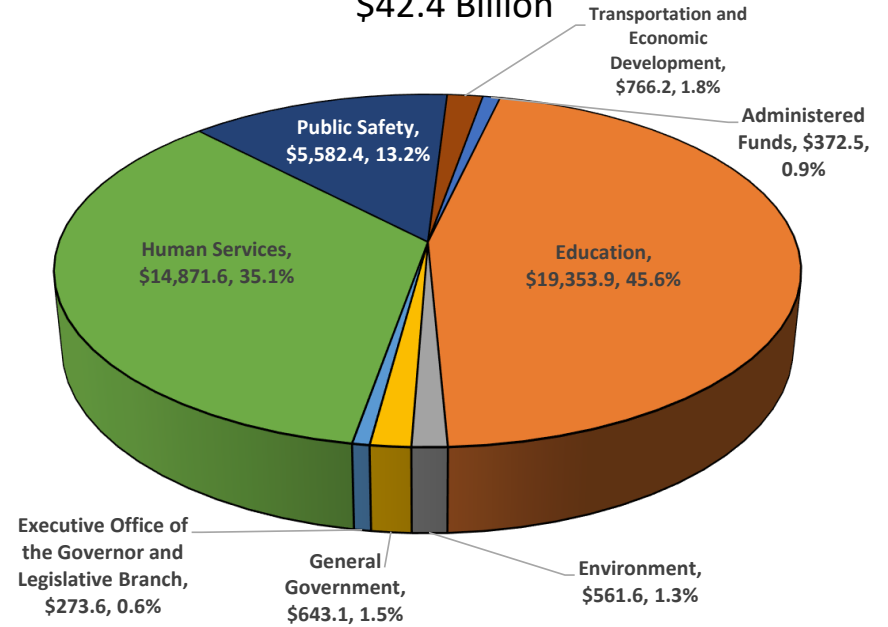

- Education represents the largest portion of the General Revenue budget

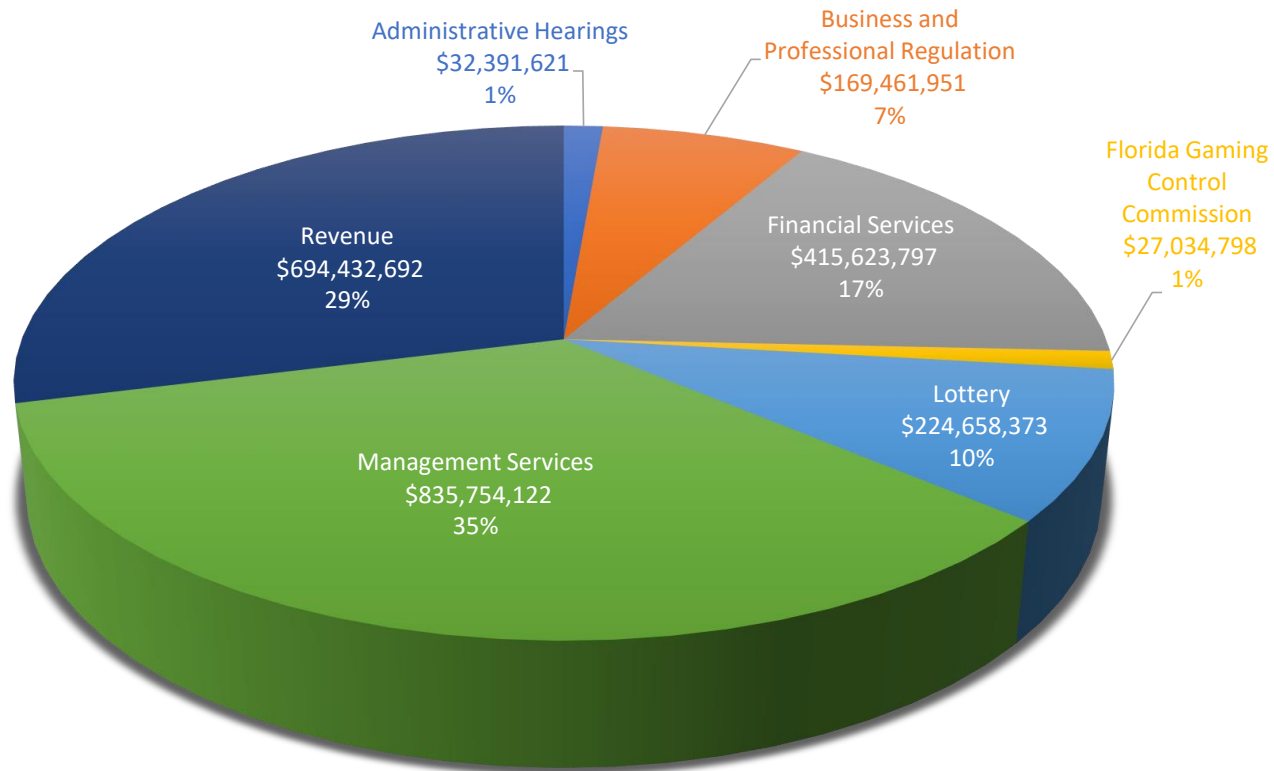

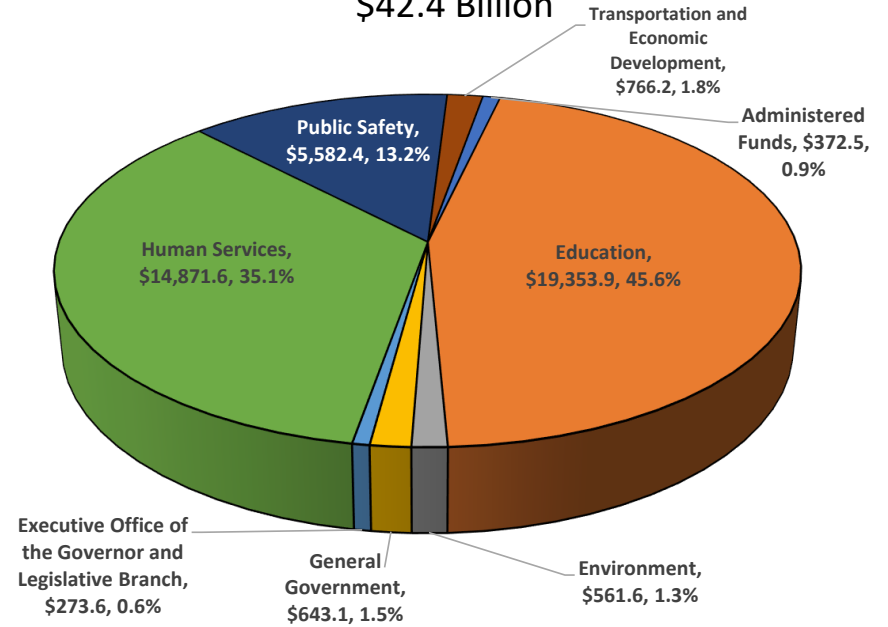

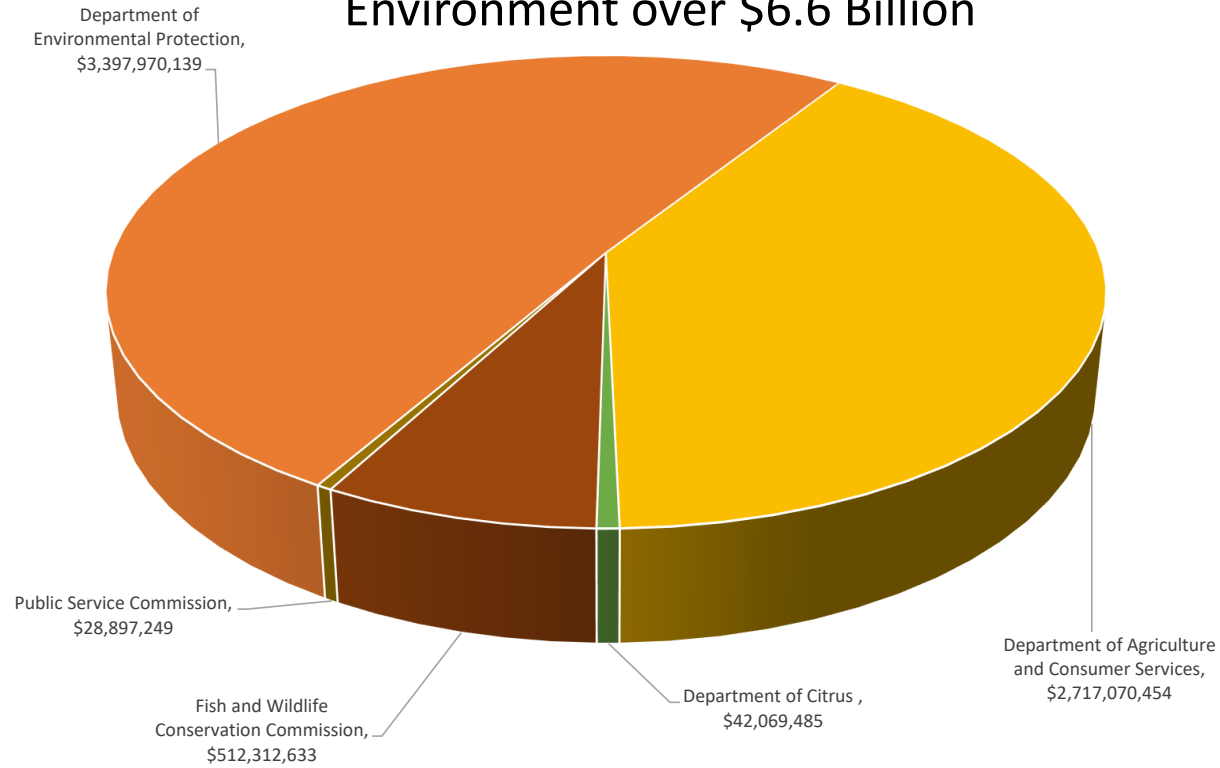
