2	<b>SB 662</b> Burton (Similar H 977, Compare H 1059, Linked S 1182)	Virtual Currency Kiosk Businesses; Requiring the Office of Financial Regulation of the Financial Services Commission to supervise registrants; prohibiting a virtual currency kiosk business from operating without registering with the state; requiring certain entities to be licensed as money services businesses; specifying application requirements for registering as a virtual currency kiosk business; specifying requirements for specified disclosures and attestations displayed by the virtual currency kiosk, etc.  BI      01/22/2024 Fav/CS AEG FP	Fav/CS Yeas 9 Nays 0
3	<b>SB 1074</b> Calatayud (Identical H 1031)	Debt Relief Services; Specifying that provisions for enforcement of violations involving credit counseling services or debt management services do not apply to debt relief services; authorizing the Attorney General to bring certain actions for violations of specified federal regulations of debt relief services, etc.  BI      01/22/2024 Fav/CS CM RC	Fav/CS Yeas 10 Nays 0

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4	<b>SB 1078</b> DiCeglie (Compare H 991)	Public Records/Cellular Telephone Numbers Held by the Department of Financial Services; Providing an exemption from public records requirements for cellular telephone numbers relating to records of certain insurance-related licensures held by the Department of Financial Services; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemptions; providing a statement of public necessity, etc.  BI      01/22/2024 Favorable GO RC	Favorable Yeas 9 Nays 0
5	<b>SB 1098</b> DiCeglie (Similar H 989, Compare H 991, H 1263, S 7028)	Department of Financial Services; Renaming the Division of Investigative and Forensic Services in the Department of Financial Services as the Division of Criminal Investigations; revising requirements for My Safe Florida Home Program mitigation inspections and mitigation grants; providing requirements for certain contracts entered into and purchases made by the Florida Joint Underwriting Association; revising the duties of the State Fire Marshal; revising the date on which stocks and other equity interests in business associations are presumed unclaimed, etc.  BI      01/22/2024 Fav/CS AEG FP	Fav/CS Yeas 9 Nays 0
6	<b>SB 1104</b> Bradley (Similar H 1149)	Policy Cancellations and Nonrenewals by Property Insurers; Prohibiting insurers from canceling and nonrenewing within certain timeframes policies covering commercial properties damaged by hurricanes and wind losses; prohibiting eligible surplus lines insurers from canceling and nonrenewing within certain timeframes policies covering dwellings and residential properties damaged by hurricanes and wind losses; providing that such prohibition applies to flood damages caused by hurricanes, etc.  BI      01/22/2024 Favorable JU RC	Favorable Yeas 10 Nays 0

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7	<b>SB 1336</b> Grall (Identical H 1253)	Interest on Trust Accounts; Requiring the Chief Financial Officer to set the rate of interest payable by eligible institutions on interest on trust accounts quarterly, effective on specified dates; providing that the percentage yield of such rate may not exceed a specified threshold; requiring the Chief Financial Officer to inform Funding Florida Legal Aid of the rate established for the quarter; requiring that such institutions submit to Funding Florida Legal Aid a certain form promulgated by The Florida Bar, etc.  BI 01/22/2024 Favorable AEG FP	Favorable Yeas 8 Nays 2
8	<b>SB 1436</b> Burton (Similar H 1347)	Consumer Finance Loans; Defining the term "branch"; prohibiting a person from operating a branch of a business making consumer finance loans before obtaining a license from the Office of Financial Regulation; specifying application fees for branch licenses; requiring licensees offering an assistance program to borrowers after a federally declared disaster to send a specified notice to the office within a certain timeframe; requiring certain licensees to suspend specified actions for a certain timeframe after a federally declared disaster, etc.  BI 01/22/2024 Favorable AEG FP	Favorable Yeas 7 Nays 2
9	<b>SB 1716</b> Boyd (Similar H 1503, Compare H 1213)	Citizens Property Insurance Corporation; Providing that certain accounts for Citizens Property Insurance Corporation revenues, assets, liability, losses, and expenses are now maintained as the Citizens account; revising the requirements for certain coverages by the corporation; deleting provisions relating to emergency assessments upon determination of projected deficits; deleting provisions relating to funds available to the corporation as sources of revenue and bonds; revising eligibility for commercial lines residential risks coverage by the corporation, etc.  BI 01/22/2024 Temporarily Postponed AEG FP	Temporarily Postponed
