Prohibits local governments from restricting access to public facilities or infrastructure for certain activities based on whether a blood establishment is operating as a for-profit organization or not-for-profit organization. 2	SB 376 Gaetz (Similar H 493)	Tax on Sales, Use, and Other Transactions; Provides definitions related to the tourist development tax. Exempts certain unrelated persons from the requirement to separately state the amount of the tourist development tax.
