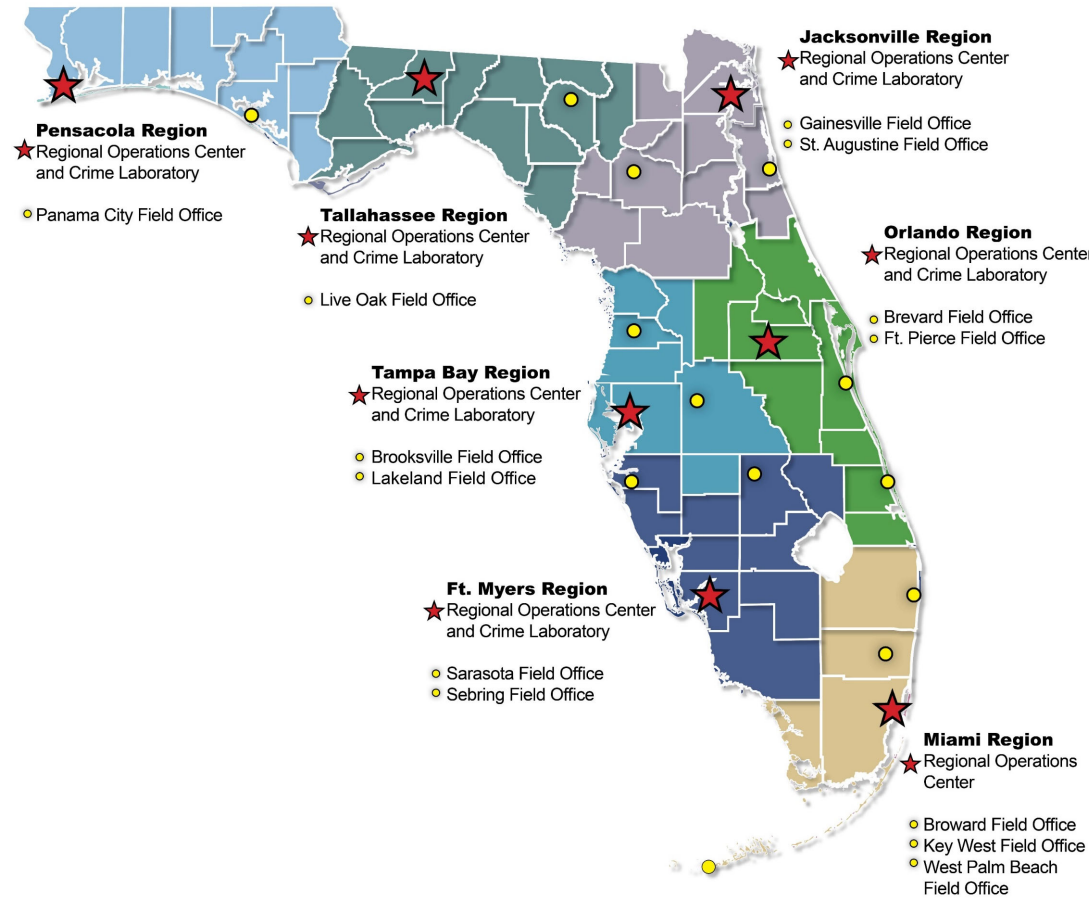

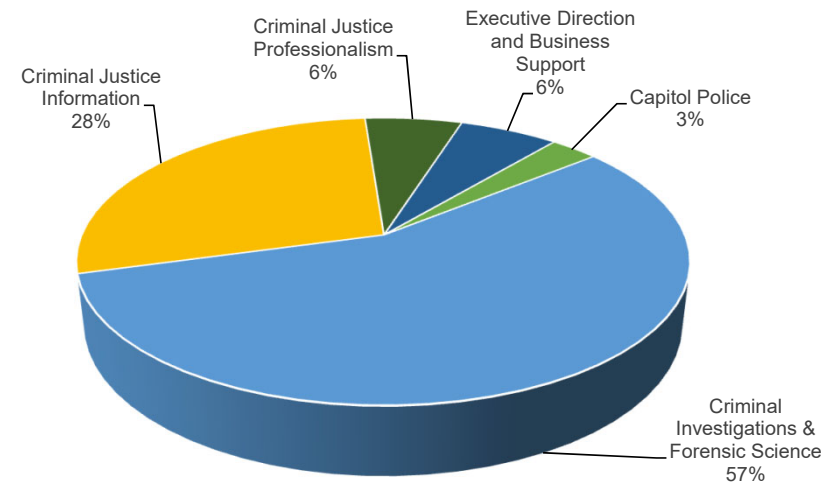

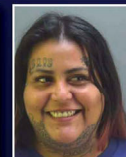

OPERATION 13 TIERS



The investigation identified the leader of the Florida gang as Carlos Martinez, a Florida prison inmate. From inside the prison, Martinez and his co-conspirators instructed gang members with the ability to move large shipments of narcotics across the United States and distribute it in Florida. Over the course of the investigation, FDLE agents, Hendry County Sheriff's deputies, HSI and FBI agents seized large shipments of drugs and weapons including:



- 380 + pounds of methamphetamine drugs
- 48 pounds of fentanyl
- 15,000 fentanyl pills
- 1 pound of heroin
- ½ pound of morphine
- 45 guns
- \$150,000 of US currency
