3	<b>SB 1302</b> Evers (Similar CS/CS/H 841)	Contaminated Sites; Requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to include protocols for the use of long-term natural attenuation where site conditions warrant; revising how cleanup target levels are applied where surface waters are exposed to contaminated groundwater; providing that institutional controls are not required under certain circumstances if using alternative cleanup target levels, etc.  EP      03/31/2015 Fav/CS AGG AP	Fav/CS Yeas 8 Nays 0
