1	CS/SB 86 Transportation / Gaetz (Similar H 1247)	<p>Commercial Motor Vehicles Operated by Unauthorized Aliens; Declaring the policy of the state with respect to the operation of commercial motor vehicles by unauthorized aliens; requiring sworn law enforcement officers with certain authority to take into custody persons determined to be unauthorized aliens operating commercial motor vehicles and facilitate the transfer of such persons into the custody of a federal immigration agency; requiring the impoundment and removal of a commercial motor vehicle under certain circumstances; providing that motor carriers are liable for certain civil penalties, etc.</p> <p>TR 01/27/2026 Fav/CS CJ 02/11/2026 Favorable FP 02/18/2026</p>	
2	SB 554 Bernard (Similar CS/CS/H 797)	<p>Nonprofit Corporations; Renaming the "Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act" as the "Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act"; revising the circumstances in which a domestic or foreign corporation may correct a document filed with the department; requiring all courts, public offices, and official bodies to receive all certificates issued by the department as <i>prima facie</i> evidence of certain facts; authorizing a corporation to register under a name that is not otherwise distinguishable on the records of the department under certain circumstances; prohibiting a corporation from paying any dividend and making distributions of any part of its net income or net earnings to its members, directors, or officers, etc.</p> <p>CM 01/21/2026 Favorable JU 02/10/2026 Favorable FP 02/18/2026</p>	

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3	CS/SB 760 Criminal Justice / McClain (Identical CS/CS/H 397)	Violations of Pretrial Release Conditions for Violent Crimes; Citing this act as the “Victim Safety in Pretrial Release Act”; providing that a person who is on pretrial release for a specified violent crime commits a separate criminal offense if such person willfully violates certain conditions of pretrial release; providing criminal penalties; providing that a law enforcement officer is not liable in a civil action for an arrest of a person based on probable cause to believe that the person has violated a condition of pretrial release in specified circumstances; authorizing a law enforcement officer to arrest a person without a warrant if there is probable cause to believe that the person has willfully violated certain conditions of pretrial release, etc.	
4	SB 774 Pizzo (Identical H 451)	911 Public Safety Telecommunicator Employment-related Mental or Nervous Injuries; Defining the term “911 public safety telecommunicator”; providing that specified provisions relating to certain medical benefits for mental or nervous injuries for first responders also apply to 911 public safety telecommunicators, etc.	
5	SB 778 Simon (Similar H 569)	Forensic Services for Certain Defendants; Revising the definition of the term “forensic client” or “client”, etc.	
6	CS/SB 844 Appropriations Committee on Health and Human Services / Jones (Identical CS/H 353)	Sickle Cell Disease Care Management and Treatment Continuing Education; Revising requirements for a continuing education course on prescribing controlled substances which health care practitioners are required to complete, etc.	

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7	SB 1022	Children's Initiatives; Establishing the Bay County 32401 Children's Initiative in Bay County and the Pompano RYZE Children's Initiative in Broward County; providing for the projects to be managed by not-for-profit corporations; declaring that the initiatives are subject to state public records and meeting requirements and procurement of commodities and contractual services requirements; requiring designated children's initiatives to assist in the creation of community-based service networks and programming that provides certain services for children and families residing in disadvantaged areas of this state, etc.	CF 02/03/2026 Favorable AHS 02/12/2026 Favorable FP 02/18/2026

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11	SB 1594 Gaetz (Compare CS/H 1327)	Veteran Benefit Payments to Minor Clients; Authorizing the Department of Children and Families, the Department of Health, or the Agency for Persons with Disabilities to access certain benefit payments for specified purposes; prohibiting the Department of Children and Families, the Department of Health, or the Agency for Persons with Disabilities from supplanting certain financial assistance, etc.	CF 01/27/2026 Favorable MS 02/11/2026 Favorable FP 02/18/2026
12	CS/SB 1630 Children, Families, and Elder Affairs / Grall (Compare CS/H 1121, CS/S 1404)	Aging and Disability Services; Deleting expired requirements for Medicaid recipients to receive an offer for enrollment for long-term care services; requiring the CARES program to review or perform the initial assessment of an enrollee's level of care; providing procurement requirements for area agencies on aging; requiring that high-risk vulnerable adults be given priority consideration for receiving community-care-for-the-elderly services; revising professional and public guardians' continuing education requirements to include Alzheimer's disease and related dementias, etc.	CF 01/27/2026 Fav/CS AHS 02/12/2026 Favorable FP 02/18/2026
