# **2021 Department of Revenue Tax Concepts**

### 1. Electronic Records/Sales Tax Audit

Allows efficient, cost-effective tax administration by removing language requiring auditors to physically visit dealers for sales tax audits and requires dealers to provide electronic records when the dealer currently maintains the records in an electronic format.

# 2. Forwarding Agent Certificate

Creates an efficient, consistent method for forwarding agents to prove the tax-free status of purchases delivered for export. Provides an online system for vendors to verify tax-free status similar to verification of resale certificates.

# 3. Heavy Minerals Tax Rate

Adds language to allow the prior year's tax rate to be used if the current producer price index can no longer be calculated and there is no comparable index.

## 4. Theft of State Funds

Updates current language to clarify that aggregation of collection periods is permitted to determine the degree of criminal offense for failure to remit taxes.

# 5. Property Tax Installment Payments/Remove Penalty

Allows all taxpayers on the installment payment plan to pay the first installment of property taxes by July 31 without penalty. Taxpayers paying on time by June 30 would continue to receive a 6% discount. Current law allows inconsistent treatment of taxpayers across the state by allowing tax collectors to decide whether to accept late payments and imposes a 5% penalty in addition to loss of the discount when tax collectors accept late payments.
