Purpose

Veterans Florida is a non-profit created by the State of Florida in 2014 to help veterans fully transition to civilian life in the Sunshine State and to promote Florida as the most military and veteran-ready state in the country. We serve:

- Separating or retiring servicemembers
- Recently transitioned veterans
- Florida National Guard and Reserves
- Spouses
- Veteran-owned businesses
- Employers seeking military talent



Administration

- Administer the Florida Veterans Employment and Training Services (VETS) Program under the Florida Department of Veterans Affairs.

- To gain workforce training at employer or industry partner under an apprenticeship or internship in lieu of their military duties.
- Retain their full DoD pay and benefits.

Employers do not provide salary or benefits for the servicemember during the training.
