SENATOR DR. BARBARA SHARIEF LEGISLATIVE SESSION 2026 UPDATE

SB 30 — Rate Filings for Property Insurers

Limits excessive property-insurance rate increases and boosts consumer protections.

SB 32 — Injunctions for Protection

Strengthens injunction options and protections for victims of serious or repeated violence.

SB 34 - Historic Cemeteries Program

Creates a statewide program to identify, preserve, and protect historic cemeteries.

SB 36 — Use of Professional Nursing Titles

Ensures proper use of protected nursing titles and professional credentials.

SB 38 — Parity for Nonnursing Services Under Long-Term Managed Care Plans Provides equal treatment and funding for non-nursing long-term care services.

SB 40 - Medicaid Providers

Ensures Medicaid enrollees have evening/weekend access and strengthens provider availability standards.

SB 42 — Specific Medical Diagnoses in Child Protective Investigations

Requires DCF to consider medical diagnoses to prevent wrongful family separations.

SB 54 — Use of Substances Affecting Cognitive Function

Regulates substances that significantly impair cognitive function and may impact public safety.

SB 56 — Residential Impacts from Mining Activities

Addresses mining-related property damage and strengthens protections for nearby residents.

SB 94 — Suicide Prevention for Active & Former Military Members

Expands suicide-prevention programs for active-duty service members, Guard/Reserve, and veterans.

SB 96 — Veterans Dental Care Grant Program

Creates a statewide grant program to provide dental care for veterans.

SB 190 - Impact of Perimenopause & Menopause on Women's Health

Improves research, education, and policy regarding menopause and perimenopause.

SB 196 — Uterine Fibroid Research Database

Creates a statewide database to improve research, data collection, and treatment policy for uterine fibroids.

SB 210 — Public Records / Protection Petitions for Serious Violence

Protects sensitive personal information in petitions for serious-violence protection orders.

Presenting SB 96 was especially meaningful. This bill expands dental care access for Florida veterans by updating program eligibility and providing recurring funding to support essential oral health services. Ensuring our veterans receive the care they deserve is a priority, and I'm grateful that SB 96 passed its first committee.





I was proud to present SB 32, a bill that improves transparency and strengthens oversight in property insurance rate filings. It ensures insurers use clear, reviewable data and enhances consumer protections. I'm grateful it passed its first committee and look forward to advancing this important work for Florida homeowners.



With SB 210, my focus was on strengthening safety and protecting privacy. This bill shields sensitive information in certain injunction petitions until the respondent is served. I appreciate the thoughtful discussion from my colleagues, and I'm glad to report the bill advanced through its first committee.



11/18/25 -

I brought forward SB 40 to make sure Medicaid enrollees can get care when they need it. This bill requires managed care plans to offer more after-hours and weekend appointments and keep their provider directories up to date. By improving access and accountability, SB 40 helps families avoid unnecessary delays. I'm pleased it cleared its first committee with strong support.




