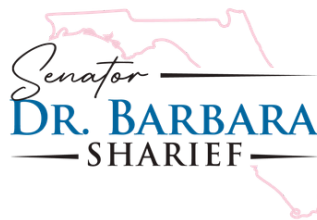
Across District 35, the focus remains on staying connected to our community and the priorities that matter most.

Florida Licensing On Wheels (FLOW) mobile offices provide the following services directly to our communities.

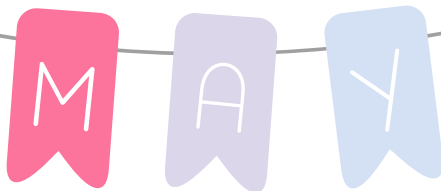
- Original Class E (includes Learner’s license and Out of State Reciprocity (\$48.00) \*

- Original/Renewal Commercial Driver License (\$75.00 plus \$7.00 per endorsement)
- Reinstatements (fees vary)
- Emergency Contact Information Registration (free)
