SENATE BILL 94

SUICIDE PREVENTION FOR ACTIVE AND FORMER MEMBERS
OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, THE NATIONAL
GUARD, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE RESERVE COMPONENTS

Strengthens suicide prevention efforts by requiring mental health care providers to identify and report whether a patient receiving evaluation or treatment is a current or former member of the U.S. Armed Forces, National Guard, or reserves. The goal is to improve data sharing and coordination so veterans and service members can receive timely, targeted mental health support.

SENATE BILL 96

DENTAL CARE FOR VETERANS

Creates the Veterans Dental Care Program within the Florida
Department of Veterans' Affairs to expand access to quality dental
services for veterans who may not qualify for federal benefits. The
program encourages collaboration with community partners and
dental providers to deliver affordable, accessible care across the
state. It also allows the department to pursue funding through state
appropriations, grants, and private donations, ensuring Florida's
veterans receive the comprehensive support they deserve.

SENATE BILL 190

IMPACTS OF PERIMENOPAUSE AND MENOPAUSE ON WOMEN'S HEALTH

Directs the Florida Department of Health to create a policy workgroup focused on perimenopause and menopause. The workgroup will collaborate with medical experts and community partners to increase awareness, improve education, and strengthen support for women's health during these life stages.

SENATE BILL 196

UTERINE FIBROID RESEARCH DATABASE

Enhances Florida's Uterine Fibroid Research Database to improve data collection, research, and public awareness surrounding uterine fibroids. By supporting better education and understanding, the measure aims to advance care and outcomes for women affected by the condition.

SENATE BILL 210

PUBLIC RECORDS/PETITIONS FOR INJUNCTIONS FOR PROTECTION AGAINST SERIOUS VIOLENCE BY A KNOWN PERSON

Creates a public records exemption for petitions seeking injunctions for protection against acts of violence by a known person. It safeguards the identifying information of petitioners and respondents to protect privacy, prevent potential harm, and ensure sensitive cases are handled with care and confidentiality.


NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH
