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HB 327 Signed Into Law

Tallahassee, FL – **Senator Barbara Sharief** (Davie) released the following statement after Governor Ron DeSantis signed HB 327 – Uterine Fibroid Research Database into law.

Sponsored by **Representative Lisa Dunkley** in the House and carried in the Senate by Senator Sharief, the legislation strengthens Florida’s uterine fibroid research database to improve data collection, transparency, and long-term research related to a condition that affects millions of women.

“Today marks an important step forward for women’s health in Florida,” said **Senator Sharief**. “HB 327 helps ensure the uterine fibroid research database is properly implemented while supporting meaningful research, greater awareness, and better health outcomes for women across our state.”

Representative Dunkley added:

“Today, Florida took an important step forward in prioritizing women’s health and expanding access to better healthcare outcomes for women across our state. HB 327 establishes the Uterine Fibroids Research Database to strengthen research, improve early detection and treatment options, and help address the disparities that have impacted far too many women for generations.

I am proud to have sponsored this legislation alongside Representative Susan Valdés and Senator Barbara Sharief to ensure women and families have access to better information, better care, and a stronger healthcare future in Florida.”

HB 327 takes effect on **July 1, 2026**.

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
