**CS/SB 32- Injunctions for Protections & SB 210 -Public Records/Petitions for
Injunctions for Protection Against Serious Violence by a Known Person**

TALLAHASSEE, FL — Senate Bills 32 (CS/SB 32) & SB 210, sponsored by **Senator Barbara Sharief**, have passed unanimously out of the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice and will now advance to the Fiscal Policy Committee for further consideration.

CS/SB 32 strengthening access to injunctions for protection by clarifying definitions, removing filing fees, and improving enforcement procedures, while SB 210 complements it by safeguarding sensitive public records related to these petitions to protect individuals seeking relief from serious violence.

“CS/SB 32 reflects a thoughtful, balanced approach to strengthening protections for individuals facing serious violence, while ensuring clarity and consistency in how these injunctions are processed and enforced,” said **Senator Sharief** while “SB 210 strikes an important balance between transparency and personal safety”.

If passed, this legislation would take effect on July 1, 2026.
