Thank you for taking the time to express your concerns to me regarding the accident that occurred Saturday night on West University Avenue. This accident is a tragedy in our community and has impacted one too many lives. As a parent whose children have both attended the University of Florida, I grieve with the university's student body, families, parents, and faculty and staff.

At this time, there is still a lot of unknown in regards to the nature of the crash. I am working closely with the Florida Department of Transportation, law enforcement officers, and city officials to thoroughly investigate the accident and determine what safety measures need to be in

As Vice Chairman of the Florida Senate Committee on Transportation, I will work to restore safety and prioritize viable solutions on this matter. Right now, I am drafting legislation to address traffic and pedestrian safety. This bill would require crosswalks to be coordinated with traffic control signal devices and require a vehicle to come to a complete stop before pedestrians are permitted to enter a crosswalk. I filed similar legislation last year and I am hoping to work closely with my colleagues in the Legislature to pass this bill.

I know that this accident has caused many heavy hearts for our community members and I will continue to fight for your voices and the safety of our collective community while in Tallahassee. My thoughts and prayers are with the family of Maggie Paxton, Sophia Lambert, and all students affected during this difficult time.
