Senator Taddeo to Governor Ron DeSantis: Governor now is not the time to play political games, it is time to govern. Hospitalizations of COVID-19 have sky-rocketed among the unvaccinated, especially in younger patients. Senator Taddeo has sent two letters to Governor Ron DeSantis asking him to declare a state of emergency to provide our hospitals and medical professionals the resources they require due to the recent spike in cases. Since then, a state of emergency has not been called and Florida has reached record COVID cases and hospitals have suspended elective surgeries and some have required vaccinations within their staff to curb the spread.
