#### **Hurricane Preparation**

Below is a checklist to go through before storm season starts, along with some important tips to remember if a storm hits the Central Florida area. # **Hurricane Guide**

### **△** Before the Storm

Taking the time to assemble your hurricane kits in advance can significantly lower stress levels during an emergency. Check out our checklist below for suggested tasks to complete by early June.

- Create a **hurricane survival kit** with enough food and water for every member of your family, including your pets, to survive 5-7 days.
- Conduct an annual **insurance checkup** with your insurance agent to make sure you are adequately covered.
- Ensure your essential **documents and identification** are in an easy to access and waterproof place during an emergency.
- Know your **flood zone** and prepare an evacuation route in case of major storms. Be conscious and keep a full tank of gas in preparation.
- Check your counties' resources for your closest **shelter** in case you need to evacuate. Check to ensure if it is petfriendly as some shelters do not accept pets.
