Senator Ileana García Appointed Chair of the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice

Miami-Senator Ileana García (R-Miami) has been named the chair of the Appropriations Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice, where she will play a crucial role in securing essential funding for Florida's law enforcement agencies and judicial system to safeguard its citizens. Senator Albritton (R-Wauchula) remarked, "A solid foundation of law and order is essential for meaningful action. Senator García is a passionate advocate for justice, dedicated to ensuring that our police and judicial systems have the necessary resources to maintain public safety." Furthermore, Senator Albritton is set to take on the role of President of the Senate starting November 19, 2024, for a two-year term.

As elected officials, it is our duty to provide these children with the necessary tools to navigate challenges early in life, thus preventing them from facing the repercussions in adulthood. I firmly believe in rehabilitation, healing, and the fresh opportunities that life can provide. I am honored to take on this role," Senator García stated.

Our commitment will focus on rehabilitation, healing, and offering second chances to individuals, ensuring their successful reintegration into society and the safety of all citizens," she concluded.
