This week, seven bills successfully passed through their committees:

- SB 638: Home Inspectors
- SB 878: Probation for Misdemeanor Offense
- SB 1084: Sexual Cyberharassment
- SB 1654: Registration of Sexual Predators and Sexual Offenders
- SB 1774: Rebuttable Presumption for Certain Deaths
- SB 1822: Regulation of Auxiliary Containers
- SB 1838: Tampering With, Harassing, or Retaliating Against Court Officials
