This week, six bills successfully passed through their respective committees, including:

- SB 676 – Minimum Wage Requirements
- SB 716 – Sexual Offenses by Persons Previously Convicted of Sexual Offenses
- SB 884 – Florida State Guard
- SB 106 – Exploitation of Vulnerable Adults
- SB 878 – Probation for Misdemeanor Offenses
- SB 628 – Lucy's Law

My staff anticipates that even more bills will be up for discussion in committee next week. Stay tuned for further updates!
