The nonrecurring sum of \$15,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund provided to the Department of Health for Zika research in budget amendment EOG #B2017-0169 and subsequently reappropriated in budget amendment EOG #B2018-0011 under the authority of Executive Order #17-166 is reverted immediately. If \$15,000,000 in funds are not available to revert pursuant to this section, the nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund provided in the fourth paragraph of proviso in Specific Appropriation 217 shall be reduced by the difference between \$15 million and the amount actually reverted pursuant to this section. This section shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
