The unexpended balance of funds provided to the Department of Legal Affairs in Specific Appropriation 1322 and section 101 of chapter 2022-156, Laws of Florida, for the Agency-wide Information Technology Modernization Program, shall revert and is appropriated to the department for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 for the same purpose. These funds shall be placed in reserve. The department is authorized to submit quarterly budget amendments to request release of funds being held in reserve pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216, Florida Statutes, and based on the department's planned quarterly expenditures. Release is contingent upon the approval of a detailed operational work plan and a monthly spend plan that identifies all related work and costs budgeted for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. The department shall submit quarterly project status reports to the Executive Office of the Governor's Office of Policy and Budget, the chair of the Senate Committee. Each status report shall include progress made to date for each project milestone, deliverable, and task order; planned and actual completion dates; planned and actual costs incurred; and any project issues and risks.
