1. Title of Project: City of Juno Beach: University Blvd. Improvements

#### 4. Project/Program Description:

The proposed project is the replacement and improvement to the Universe Boulevard drainage system, located within the Town of Juno Beach Florida. The grant request will fund the removal of the existing facilities (approximately 5,000 LF of drainage pipe), construction of the new element and construction inspection activities. The roadway drainage system serves to provide legal positive outfall for adjacent properties as well as provide a means of conveyance for storm runoff to the Intracoastal Waterway. The project has been designed to enhance the quality of water entering the AICW. While the replacement of the deteriorating stormwater pipe represents the proposed project, of equal concern is a 12" water main which runs parallel to this pipe. Should the storm water pipe collapse, it could undermine the water main and cause it to rupture. If this were to happen, it would be an extremely disruptive situation with a lack of potable water to the properties and possible property damage.

The completion of the proposed project will impact both critical facilities and hundreds of residential dwellings. The headquarters of Florida Power Light would be impacted by the project. The company's facility is home to over 2500 employees. As the State's largest provider of electricity ensuring continuity of operations is critical. Without the completion of the project the potential for flooding, loss of water/sewer and transportation disruption would grow as the underground infrastructure continues to age. The same potential impacts also effect the Waterford, a large senior living and health care facility. The Waterford is home to 350 senior residents. The sudden loss of water and sewer service and/or road damage could hinder the ability of the facility to care for and transport its hundreds of elderly residents. Hundreds of apartments, condos and town homes would be affected as well.
