This facility needs repairs/renovation to provide a safe facility for residents, visitors, businesses and the surrounding areas to attend/host local and state-wide programs, concerts, performances and events. Construction, repairs, and renovations are needed to bring this facility up to current code that includes ADA accessibility of bathrooms, parking, roof repairs, window replacements, ceiling repairs, etc. The City of Wauchula is a financially disadvantaged municipality located in a Rural Area of Economic Opportunity, formerly known as a RACEC community (a rural area of critical economic concern); as designated by the Governor in Executive Order No. 11-81 and as per F.S. 288.0656 Rural Economic Development Initiative and F.S. 288.06561 Reduction or Waiver of Financial Match.

Once completed, the direct services provided to citizens in this financially disadvantaged community will be the use of a safe facility that meets current building codes, including ADA requirements and the permitting agencies' requirements.

 - Target population in this rural area of opportunity is residents, visitors, elderly persons, students, economically disadvantaged persons, etc. and the surrounding areas. Population expected to be served exceeds 25,000.
- f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
 - Expected outcome is a safe facility upon completion of the construction/repair and renovations as described in Question 4. Outcome will be measured by the engineer's certification and acceptance by the permitting agencies. Once completed, the facility will provide for an increase in revenues, i.e., sales tax, state tax, etc. from concerts, performances, programs and events that will be held in this safe facility and attended by the targeted audiences.

 Suggested penalties -- withhold payment, establish a correction action plan, and if necessary, liquidated damages will be assessed per the terms of the contract.
