d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Increase the amount of legal drivers on Florida highways and roads by lawfully reinstating licenses and increasing the amount of drivers eligible to obtain state required insurance

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>The targeted population served by this project includes: elderly persons, jobless persons, economically</u> <u>disadvantaged persons and university/college students. In Miami-Dade County approximately 500,000 drivers</u> <u>licenses are suspended. It is estimated that over 100,000 people drive with a suspended license. The DWLS</u> <u>Project anticipates resolving 1,000 cases per week.</u>

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>The expected outcome is to reduce the number of people with a suspended license by providing a mechanism</u> for payment of fines and costs and to increase the amount of people driving legally. The methodology to



measure the outcome includes gathering data documenting the amount of tickets, warrants and arrests related to driving with a suspended license pre and post pilot program.
