<u>Increase school readiness and boost long-term school success for the children and families of Riviera Beach</u> through supports to existing community early learning programs.

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Riviera Beach Early Learning to Kindergarten Pilot is focused on creating a community support network that assures every child in Riviera Beach has access to a high-quality preschool education. This is a partnership between community stakeholders, Riviera Beach early learning programs, the School District of Palm Beach County, the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County (a local special taxing district focused on early childhood outcomes) and the Early Learning Coalition of Palm Beach County. The pilot activities are aimed at building upon the existing strengths of each early learning program and supplementing with the following supports and services: 1) Family Advocates, who will be trained social workers, who will work with the families of children attending the pilot programs to create family goals and increase their advocacy for their child's education and within their community. 2) Contracted child care and program support staff.

Support for early learning programs in Riviera Beach through 1) Family supports via Family Advocates, Family Engagement activities and a Parenting Support program 2) Program supports via therapists, nutritionists, and education specialists, plus an additional aide per classroom 3) Ongoing independent child assessment to measure progress and plan for continuous improvement 4) Program materials to ehance classroom settings 6) Strong ongoing connections with Kindergarten faculty from the community schools

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Three and four year old children in Riviera Beach attend partner early learning programs with an estimate of 300 children to be served.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Riviera Beach Early Learning to Kindergarten Pilot is focused on an increase in Kindergarten readiness rates and overall school success however the collaborative understands there are multiple factors to reach this goal. Project deliverables include: Family supports and education to increase parental engagement and advocacy 2) Provision of support services for children and families who demonstrate a need in the form of therapy services, speech services and nutrition supports. 3)Increasing support to early learning program administrators and teaching staff in the form of professional development and on-site technical assistance to maximize the efforts while children are in program. 4)Create opportunities for early learning programs and elementary school teachers to dialogue frequently on the transition process and the Kindergarten/school experience.
