<u>The goal of this project is to achieve habitat restoration and public recreation through a sustainable balance of ecological enhancement and passive use access improvements. The project is located at the confluence of Sarasota and Tampa Bays, both federally recognized estuaries of national significance, and is supported by both respective national estuary programs' Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plans (CCMP) for benefits to habitats, fisheries, wildlife, education, and outreach.c</u>

d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

<u>Habitat Restoration, Ecosystem Services, and Recreational Opportunities. An educational center is funded with</u> <u>other monies.</u>

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>The general public: both resident and tourists expected to visit Robinson Preserve Expansion area. Current</u> visitation in the adjacent completed phases of Robinson Preserve is in excess of 300,000 per year.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Enriched cultural experience: Preserve patrons will experience restored habitats that historically existed in coastal Manatee County and are intertwined with a local cultural heritage valuing natural landscapes. Outcomes will be measured by biannual traffic counts of people visiting the preserves. Enhance/preserve/improve environmental or fish and wildlife quality: Habitat Restoration will be measured in acres of habitat improved. Method for measuring level of benefit will be by qualitative analysis of plant communities with monitoring performed by Manatee County Staff. Improve stormwater management, groundwater quality, and surfacewater quality: Reestablishment of desirable native vegetation will aid in nutrient uptake and storm water infiltration prior to discharge into surface waters. Benefits are assumed based on available science and regulatory practices. Measurement of benefit will be by acres of restored habitat. Benefits are assumed based on available science and regulato
