- 4. Project/Program Description:

There are approximately 3600 properties within the service area of Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Dept. that are currently served by private wells. Many of these homes were built on former agricultural lands before public water supplies were available. Several instances of pesticide contamination have been detected by monitoring. While DEP provides on-site treatment systems to homes where drinking water standards are exceeded, no assistance is available to neighbors who may have detections but not exceedances. Extending water mains is a better solution but can cost about \$30k per property for water main installation. State assistance will make this option more affordable and more completely address the public health issues while reducing DEP's costs over the long term for on-site treatment systems.
