d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

Allowing every child at Lake Silver Elementary School the opportunity to use computers and work on STEM related curriculums on a daily basis. This initiative, started several years ago by the Lake Silver Foundation, has helped to raise FCAT test scores in science over 20%.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Lake Silver is a title 1 school. Many of the students do not have opportunities to use computers at home. This initiative once completed, will give every student at the school to opportunity to use a computer on a daily basis and increase their ability to succeed in an every changing digital world.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>This is the 4th year of a 5 year plan to bring computers and STEM curriculum to all of the students in Lake</u> <u>Silver. After 3 years of the initiative, FCAT test scores in science have increased 20%. Once the project is fully</u> <u>completed we expect increased test scores in both math and science. In addition, students will leave lake silver</u> <u>with a proficient knowledge of computer use and better understandings of Math, Science and Technology.</u>
