4. Project/Program Description:

Flagler County beaches suffered coastal impacts from Hurricanes Matthew and Irma, (and nor'easters since Irma), particularly to its dune system. While the dunes did what nature intends for them to do, sacrifice themselves, today many are either completely gone or compromised. Unfortunately, these dunes serve as a protective barrier for homes and infrastructure during high tides, 15ft. – 17 ft. wave action, storm surges, and other severe weather events directly affecting over 1,000 homes. While the dunes were severely impacted by Hurricane Matthew, Flagler's current situation was made worse by the devastating effects this September by Hurricane Irma. To restore the dunes (berms) following Matthew, the County has sought funding from private, local, state, and federal sources. The County borrowed \$6.5 million to match state and federal funding, finaning these costs for over 13 years.
