<u>The North Fork of the St. Lucie River runs through the center of the city, but most of the land along the river is</u> privately owned or a state designated preserve. The construction of the boardwalk will provide the general public with access to the river for all ages and all users.

The project will serve all city residents, visitors, and the surrounding communities.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>The project will provide enhanced public access to the North Fork of the St. Lucie River, a state designated</u> aquatic preserve. Visitors will be able to enjoy a scenic walk or bike ride and observe both marine and upland wildlife. Outcomes will be measured through an increase in tourism, sales tax revenue, and new construction, renovation, or improvements to adjacent commercial properties.
