Funded students teach undergraduate students attending participating Florida universities, serve as research and teaching assistants, help manage university research labs, provide tutorial services for precollege students, conduct workshops to train secondary teachers how to teach STEM courses, and mentor graduate, undergraduate, and precollege students.

Funded students teach undergraduate students attending participating Florida universities, serve as research and teaching assistants, help manage university research labs, provide tutorial services for precollege students, conduct workshops to train secondary teachers how to teach STEM courses, and mentor graduate, undergraduate, and precollege students.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

While attending graduate school, funded students will serve as graduate research assistants, lecturers, grant writers, instructors, lab technicians and administrators, tutors and professional consultants. After earning their Ph.D.s, they will become university professors and administrators and work in private industry and governmental agencies. They also will provide tutorial services to undergradute and precollege students. We will determine outcomes of the program by collecting data on student graduate school performance. These

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data will include students' academic standing while in graduate school, time to degree, graduation rates, professional services provided while matriculating, and employment after earning their degrees.
