The Golden Isles Drive Community in the City of Hallandale Beach is home to nearly 5,000 people. The community is less than 1 mile long and surrounded by water on both sides of the street. Due to sea level rise and poor drainage systems, after a storm this vulnerable senior community often suffers from large scale flooding and long term power loss. The full underground utilities hardening project will cost the city \$2,000,000. The city has already secured \$500,000 from the residents and is in the process of securing \$500,000 from FP&L. They are requesting \$1,000,000 from the State to help them complete the project sooner so they can protect their residents from the loss of life and property during future storms.

Burying powerlines and fixing drainage.
