<u>The method for measuring level of benefit would be qualitative and reflected in better accuracy of</u> assessments and property identification. Because the aerial photography is oftentimes shared with other local governmental entities, level of benefit would be reflected in 911 programs, emergency management, planning and zoning, and building departments.
