Florida Symphony Youth Orchestras (FSYO) exists to encourage children and young adults, through the practice and performance of orchestral music, to become passionate leaders, thinkers, and contributors in their local communities and beyond. The programs that make up the FSYO all reflect a commitment to provide young musicians with the opportunity to strengthen their musical talents and develop an appreciation of the arts through music, while also developing the strong leadership skills, dedication, discipline, accountability, and self-awareness that will lead them confidently into their future endeavors. The six FSYO orchestras and two supplementary program are carefully structured so that students can grow with the FSYO throughout their primary and secondary years. d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

<u>Citizens will receive concerts, which provide family-friendly cultural outlets for the community and educational experiences for our students.</u>

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>300 high school and grade school students from 9 central Florida counties who would be performing in the concerts; as well as 10,000+ music lovers in Central Florida who would be attending the concerts throughout the season.</u>

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

<u>Cultural Experience – Performances increase the cultural offerings in Central Florida and for our patrons. FSYO</u> <u>tracks patronage through ticket sales. Surveys are sent out to evaluate the quality of the offerings as perceived</u> <u>by patrons. Improve Quality of Education – Many FSYO students outgrow their school music programs. FSYO</u> <u>acts as a supplemental program, challenging students with an advanced music education. Student surveys are</u> <u>distributed at the end of the season to evaluate the program. Pre- and post-testing is conducted through</u> <u>auditions each year. Increase Economic Activity – FSYO patrons are more likely to use businesses that support</u>



the organization, which adds patronage and revenue. This is shown in measures by partner companies, schools, and summer programs. Create Job Opportunities – FSYO creates over 100 contracted jobs every season for a variety of employees for sectionals, concert support, design, accounting, legal, etc. This is tracked by employee contracts.
